NATURE OF WORK:

Under general supervision, examines and approves complex construction drawings and specifications of proposed buildings in order to determine compliance with applicable federal, state, and other applicable building construction codes prior to issuance of building permits.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High school graduate and five years construction experience in the mechanical discipline, or bachelor degree in mechanical engineering or a closely related field plus one year of construction experience in the mechanical discipline; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. Provisional Plans Examiners must apply and obtain a certificate from the State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation in the appropriate category/discipline (building, mechanical, plumbing, or electrical) within one year of being hired. Licensed Mechanical Plans Examiners must possess the State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulations Building Code Administrators and Inspectors Board (F.5. Chapter 468) certificate. Florida driver license required.

VALID DRIVER LICENSE FROM ANY STATE MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF INTERVIEW.
VALID FLORIDA DRIVER LICENSE MUST BE PRESENTED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF HIRE.
