**ITEM DESCRIPTION**

Recommendation to Adopt Organization Policy, Section 130.08, Organizations and Institutions Showcase Display Program and Request Funding to Establish a Showcase Display Program (Program) at the Orlando International Airport

**BACKGROUND**

The proposed policy establishes that a community organization or institution whose widely recognized and well-established record of accomplishments contributes to the quality of life and the economic vitality of Central Florida and the State is eligible to submit nominations to participate in the Program which will be reviewed by the Executive Director and the Chairman and presented to the Aviation Authority Board for consideration for inclusion in the Program.

**ISSUES**

A Showcase Display Program (Program) to display the contributions of iconic community organizations and community institutions that contribute to the quality of life and the economic vitality of Central Florida and the State at our Airports does not currently exist. Consequently, a policy is required to provide guidance to staff to administer such a Program if adopted, which proposed policy is presented here for consideration.

In addition, funding is required to procure and install sufficient display cases to administer the Program. The architects at Schenkel Shultz have assessed the initial requirements for display cases and have recommended the acquisition and installation of nine (9) mobile 4' x 4' x 8' tall units with oak wood base and glass display cases with LED lighting for the Orlando International Airport at an estimated cost of \$188,747 including taxes and installation. No display cases are recommended for Orlando Executive Airport at this time. Schenkel Schultz's assessment of the recommended display cases, installation and associated cost are attached for review. As a result, staff respectfully request an appropriation of funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, which sum represents the full amount required to initiate the Program.

**ALTERNATIVES**

There are no alternatives under consideration at this time.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The initial fiscal impact is estimated not to exceed \$200,000 with funding from the Capital Expenditures Fund for the Orlando International Airport display cases.

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to (1) approve Administration Policy Section 130.08, titled "Organizations and Institutions Showcase Display Program" to establish a Showcase Display Program at the Orlando International Airport; (2) to approve the use of unbudgeted Capital Expenditure Funds in the amount not to exceed \$200,000 to establish a Showcase Display Program at the Orlando International Airport; (3) request City Council concurrence of this unbudgeted item; and (4) authorize the Executive Director or his designee to execute all necessary documents thereto following review and approval by legal counsel.

**OBJECTIVE**

To establish a Showcase Display Program (Program) at designated facilities at Orlando International Airport and Orlando Executive Airport to display the contributions of iconic community organizations and institutions that contribute to the quality of life and the economic vitality of Central Florida and the State.

**METHOD OF  
OPERATION**

**Eligibility  
and Process**

The Policy establishes that a community organization or institution whose widely recognized and well-established record of accomplishment contributes to the well-being and economic vitality of Central Florida and the State is eligible to be recognized in the Program. Interested parties may submit nominations for the Program to the Executive Director, Greater Orlando Aviation Authority, One Jeff Fuqua Boulevard, Orlando, FL 32827.

**Nomination  
and Selection**

All nominations received to participate in the Program will be reviewed by the Executive Director and the Chairman of the Aviation Authority for inclusion in the Program. The criteria for evaluation of potential nominees shall include, but not be limited to, demonstrated record of achievement in contributing to well-being and/or economic vitality of Central Florida or the State, length of tenure in Central Florida or the State and the extent to which the community has benefited from these organizations and institutions.

The award of any nominee shall be dependent on the availability of sufficient facility space and display cases as is required to maintain the safe and efficient flow of passengers and public through the airport facilities, which determination shall be made solely by the Executive Director. The Aviation Authority will endeavor to provide sufficient facility space and display cases for each nominee. However, there is no assurance that such facility space or display cases will be available at any time. Therefore, the Aviation Authority reserves the right to limit or refrain from recommending or awarding any nominee at any time as it may deem necessary.

**Term**

Each nominee approved by the Aviation Authority Board shall be granted an initial term of one year. Each approved nominee may be presented by the Executive Director to the Aviation Authority Board each year for consideration to continue to participate in the Program after full consideration of the nominee's overall contribution to Central Florida and the State with respect to all other nominations presented. There shall be no limit regarding the length of time an approved nominee may continue in the Program. However, the Aviation Authority reserves the right to terminate the

initial term or any subsequent term granted to any nominee at any time as it may deem necessary and beneficial to the Program.

**Display  
Guidelines**

Each approved nominee will be granted restricted access by the Aviation Authority to one display case, furnished by the Aviation Authority, to showcase a limited number of momentous artifacts, memorabilia or proprietary items unique to the organization's or institution's celebrated activities, at a location determined by the Aviation Authority. Each approved nominee will be afforded an opportunity to present its recommendations for items to be included in a display case to the Aviation Authority's Design Review Committee for consideration. The content of each display case shall be determined solely by the Committee after review of the recommendations received, which determination shall be final. The Committee will endeavor to be equitable in its determinations. However, there is no assurance that the content of any display case will be deemed equitable by all parties. As such, the Aviation Authority reserves the right to restrict, remove or otherwise amend the content of any display case at any time as it further deems necessary and beneficial to the Program.
