AND** 18 SANITARIUM AVE.; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, 19 CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN 20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 21 22 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, hereby finds and 23 determines that the real property described in Exhibit "A" to this ordinance (the "Property") is no 24 longer useful and needed for public right-of-way and that it is in the best interest of the public 25 health, safety, and welfare that it be vacated, closed, and abandoned as public right-of-way; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Property is located within Orange County, Florida, and within the 28 jurisdiction of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "City"); and 29 30 **WHEREAS**, the Municipal Planning Board (MPB) of the City of Orlando approved the 31 abandonment of Guava St. at its January 21, 2014 meeting (Case ABN 2013-00005). 32 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE 34 **CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:** 35 36 SECTION 1. ABANDONMENT. The Property is hereby vacated, closed, and 37 abandoned as public right-of-way. All right, title, and interest in the Property as the City may 38 hold shall revert to those with interests provided by law. 39 40 SECTION 2. EFFECTING DOCUMENTS. The Mayor, City Clerk, and City 41 Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to execute such instruments as may be necessary or 42 convenient to implement this ordinance. 43 44 SECTION 3. SCRIVENER'S ERROR. The City Attorney may correct scrivener's 45 errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the City Clerk. 46 47

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
