**Whereas**, on July 25, 2011, the Orlando City Council adopted ordinance number 2011-28, amending Chapter 40, Code of the City of Orlando, Florida to create the Downtown South Neighborhood Improvement District (“DSNID”), in accordance with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and

**Whereas**, on February 24, 2014, the Orlando City Council adopted ordinance number 2014-6, amending section 5 of ordinance number 2011-28 regarding referendums; and

**Whereas**, pursuant to section 5 of ordinance number 2014-6, it is necessary that the Orlando City Council call for a referendum; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, as follows:

1. The Orlando City Council shall call for a referendum in accordance with section 5 of ordinance number 2014-6, and for ballots to be mailed no later than May 5, 2014.

2. This resolution takes effect immediately upon passage.

3. The City Attorney may correct scrivener's errors found in this resolution by filing a corrected copy of this resolution with the City Clerk.

4. If any provision of this resolution or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are severable.
