10	Downtown South Neighborhood Improvement District ("DSNID"), in accordance with		
11	Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and		
12	Whereas, section 40.14(1), Orlando City Code, authorizes the DSNID to levy an		
13	ad valorem tax on real and personal property of up to 2 mills annually subject to approval		
14	by referendum; and		
15	Whereas, on February 24, 2014, the Orlando City Council adopted ordinance		
16	number 2014-6, amending section 5 of ordinance number 2011-28 regarding		
17	referendums; and		
18	Whereas, also on January 27, 2014, the Orlando City Council approved the		
19	DSNID Advisory Council's recommendation to proceed with a referendum; and		
20	Whereas, pursuant to section 5 of ordinance number 2014-6, it is necessary that		
21	the Orlando City Council call for a referendum; and		
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of		
23	Orlando, Florida, as follows:		

1.	The Orlando City Co	Council shall call for a referendum in accordance with
section 5 of ordinance number 2014-6, and for ballots to be mailed no later than May 5,		
2014.		
2.	This resolution takes	s effect immediately upon passage.

4.	If any provision of	f this resolution or its application to any person or
