## Budget Workshop on June 9, 2014

At the Budget Workshop on April 28, 2014, discussion was had as to where the City had cut expenses in the last five years. In order to provide an in-depth overview, City Council has scheduled a special Budget Workshop on Monday, June 9, 2014 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Each department director will give an overview of the cuts to services and personnel that have been made in their respective departments. The workshop will be held in Council Chambers.

## Summer Safety Series with Police Chief John Mina

Recognizing the important role each community plays in keeping Orlando neighborhoods safe and recognizing that residents' engagement in the fight against crime is a proven and effective way to reduce crime, Orlando is launching a "Summer Safety Series" in May and June. Mayor Buddy Dyer, Police Chief John Mina and the City Commissioners, in partnership with Orlando citizens in the fight against crime, will introduce the new police chief to the community in each district throughout the City. The "Summer Safety Series" events will provide an opportunity for Orlando's new police chief to meet directly with the residents and businesses that the Orlando Police Department is charged with keeping safe, and to provide important information about ways in which residents can partner with the City to combat crime. ## Item C-6 - Buehner-Fry, Inc. Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Resolution

On today's agenda for consideration is a Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Resolution supporting the expansion of Buehner-Fry, Inc. Buehner-Fry, better known as NAVIS, provides innovative business solutions to hotels worldwide. In order to be closer to their east coast client base and provide an opportunity to expand their international client base, the company has plans to develop its eastern regional headquarters in Orlando. NAVIS will create 67 new high wage, high value jobs for Orlando. The Mayor recognized Ryan Tomlinson, Senior Product Manager with NAVIS, and thanked the company for its investment in our community.

## Item C-9 - Orlando E-Street Program

In 2007 the City launched the Orlando Main Street Program to help revitalize our neighborhood commercial corridors. Since its inception, the Main Street program now includes eight neighborhood districts and has impacted the Orlando community greatly, including the creation of more than 3,000 jobs and \$500 million in economic impact. Just as important as enhancing commerce, the Main Street districts have helped create a stronger sense of place in the City. At the Mayor's State of the City address, it was announced that the City will be adding its first "Digital Main Street," to be known as "E-Street". Orlando Tech, Inc. will be the newest district to join the Orlando Main Street Program. It will be a virtual community district that uses the principals of the Orlando Main Street Program to strengthen our booming tech industry. Orlando has been named one of America's most promising tech hubs and it is estimated that one in five jobs in Downtown Orlando is tech-related. Orlando Tech will continue to work to make Orlando a city where tech companies choose to locate and the digital workforce thrives. Orlando is proud of its growing tech industry and is pleased to support this new organization.

#### Item C-11 - Orlando City Soccer Club Murals

The Orlando City Soccer Club will unveil its new logo on May 13, 2014. As part of this process, the Soccer Club is requesting to install a series of temporary murals at seven locations within the City. On today's agenda for consideration is a temporary use permit for these murals. The permit will allow artists to paint murals directly on the walls of privately owned businesses in specific locations within the city. The soccer

club is also preparing a very exciting announcement this week as it leads up to its first season in major league soccer 2015. The Mayor encouraged everyone to follow the team's social media pages for more information about the planned announcement, and recognized Phil Rawlins, president of Orlando City Soccer, who attended today's council meeting.

#### Item D-1 - Recreational Trail at Park of the Americas

Also on today's agenda is a grant award that will help Orlando with the renovation and reopening of the Park of Americas. The grant will provide funding for a mixed-use recreation trail with exercise and fitness equipment. The improvement project will also add Orlando's first off-leash dog park as part of the renovation of the 28.5 acre park which is expected to open by the end of 2014. Mayor Dyer recognized Commissioner Ortiz for his hard work and leadership on this project and his dedication to District 2.

#### **District 5 Election Results**

District 5's runoff election last week resulted in Regina Hill being elected and Ms. Hill will serve as Orlando's new District 5 City Commissioner. Mayor Dyer congratulated her on her election and also congratulated Commissioner Jim Gray of District 1 and Commissioner Robert F. Stuart of District 3, who were re-elected. An Oath of Office ceremony for Districts 1, 3, and 5 Commissioners will be held on Monday, June 2, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in Council Chambers.

## Recognition of Commissioner Daisy W. Lynum

Mayor Dyer announced that today is Commissioner Daisy W. Lynum's final attendance at City Council meetings and recognized Commissioner Lynum's many years of service to the citizens of the City of Orlando. The Mayor pointed out that Commissioner Lynum is tied with former Commissioner Betty Wyman as Orlando's longest serving female City Commissioner, both having served 16 years. The Mayor honored Commissioner Lynum as Commissioner Emeritus in the City of Orlando and remarked that the City is better because of her service and that the results of her leadership throughout the years will benefit Orlando and District 5 for decades to come. The Mayor declared that it has been an honor to serve alongside Commissioner Lynum and offered all of the Commissioners the opportunity to thank Commissioner Lynum, followed by a showing of a commemorative video and presentation.
