# 1. Call to order and determination of a quorum

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 A.M.

#### 2. Public comment

Chairman Rex McPherson opened the floor for public comment. Doug Doudney asked a question about the NID Board's imminent domain powers. Kyle Shephard reviewed the power of the City as the Board of Directors for the NID, and the statutory allowance for the NID to exercise imminent domain unless the power is removed by City Council. Jason Burton noted that a change to the ordinance will be listed as an agenda item for June. Dan Peterson asked a follow up question regarding imminent domain.

# 3. Review and approval of minutes

<u>Chairman Rex McPherson opened the floor for additions or corrections to the minutes of the April 9,2014</u> <u>Advisory Council meeting. Hearing none, the minutes were approved as submitted.</u>

#### 4. Staff reports

# a. Tax-exempt property agreements

Kyle Shephard gave an update on PILOT agreements with tax exempt properties. Orlando Health is the only tax exempt entity that has agreed to make a PILOT payment. The agreement between Orlando Health and the City has been finalized and is now in effect. Kyle Shephard informed the Board the ballot counting would be done in accordance with government in the Sunshine Law.

# b. Referendum update

Jason Burton gave an update on the ad valorem referendum. 1,160 ballots have been mailed to property owners in the NID. Approximately one third of the ballots have been returned. Ballots will be opened on Wednesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>, and the results must be published by the City Clerk's Office by Sunday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### c. Consultant update

Dana Loncar and Molly Delahunty gave an update on stakeholder outreach. Two mailer pieces have been sent to landowners in the NID. Consultants made a presentation to the Downtown South Coffee Club on Wednesday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. Approximately 20 people were in attendance. Consultants received constructive feedback from stakeholders.

Mary Hurley commented regarding discussion by the exploratory committee to remove imminent domain powers given to the NID by statute.
