**WHEREAS**, only 38 percent of the U.S. population is eligible to donate blood and less than 10 percent do so annually; and

WHEREAS, one pint of blood can save up to three lives; and

**WHEREAS**, much of today's medical care depends on a steady supply of blood from healthy donors; and

**WHEREAS**, if only one more percent of all Americans would give blood, blood shortages would disappear for the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Orlando, the Church Street District, the Central Florida Hotel and Lodging Association, WFTV Channel 9 and OneBlood, our local blood center, have joined together to create Give Life Orlando; and

**WHEREAS**, Give Life Orlando will make it easy for all Downtowners to give blood to those in need; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Orlando recognizes the importance of all blood donations and the selfless act of kindness by blood donors;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Buddy Dyer, Mayor of the City of Orlando, in recognition of the importance of donating blood to save lives, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 14, 2014 as

"Give Life Orlando Day"
