The SBFP offers funds to offset the costs of façade and streetscape improvements. The City will pay 100% of the first \$1,000 of total eligible project costs and loan 80% of the remaining balance. The maximum amount loaned under the program guidelines is not to exceed \$20,000 per applicant. All applications submitted prior to October 1, 2013 qualify under these guidelines.

Total eligible project costs for Exclusive Collection, LLC d/b/a Remax Exclusive Collection under the Small Business Facade Program are \$33,650. The SBFP will pay 100% of the first \$1,000 of total eligible project costs and loan 80%

of the remaining balance. The project breakdown is as follows: Install new windows, awnings, exterior lighting, landscaping, and irrigation = \$33,650. \$32,650@80% = \$26,650+ \$1,000 = \$27,650. \$27,650-\$7,650= \$20,000.
