MINUTES:

It was moved by Philip Farris and seconded by Alberto Sanchez de Fuentes to approve the July 23, 2014 Harry P. Leu Board minutes. There was no discussion. It was approved by all as presented.

ATTENDANCE AND REVENUE:

Robert Bowden reported on the July 2014 Leu Attendance report. July 2014 attendance is higher for the month 7,456 comparing to last year July 2013 of 6,084. The financial reports estimates are still tentative and review of department revenue and expense balances are needed before presentation to the board.

It was moved by Lorelei Anderson-Francis and seconded by Philip Farris that the July 2014 Attendance report be approved. It was approved by all as presented.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Mr. Bowden informed the board of pending cost estimates to repair or replace the Rowena Overlook (formerly named Wyckoff).

Keri Leymaster Byrum informed the board of the availability of Leu Gardens' new website. The North Woods clean up of invasive plants has revealed a spectacular view of the lake. Leu Gardens' was awarded a \$150,000 Florida Department of State, Division of Cultural Affairs Grant for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

HORTICULTURE:

Robert Bowden reported from Thomas Hurst,

- With record heat of the last week, the horticulture team is working hard to stay on top of the weeds. With rain tapering off we are relying more on irrigation to get us through the heat wave and to keep the gardens looking good.
- A thorough cleaning and consolidation of plant materials in the nursery was done. This will help conserve water, fertilizer and chemicals in the upcoming months. It will allow us to close a section of the greenhouse during the colder months and only heat where needed.
- Cool weather annuals and plant material has been received and it has been potted up and ready for the cooler months ahead. This material will be used mainly in the Color Garden and in various containers throughout the gardens.

We welcomed new hire, Sarah Rosen, for the horticulture assistant position to the Gardens. Sarah was a past intern and Leu volunteer.
