Flying Taco in College Park, Inc. d/b/a PR's Taco Palace (PRs') plans to open a second location at 717 West Smith Street. PR's has served Tex-Mex fare at its Winter Park location since 1987. The project consists of relocating bathrooms and ensuring that they are ADA compliant, installation of fire sprinklers throughout building and 152 indoor and outdoor seats. PR's plans to create 25 new full-time jobs as a result of this project. Total capital investment for this project is approximately \$45,000.

Total eligible fees for PR's Taco Palace under the Business Assistance Program, are \$35,809.20. The BAP will pay fifty percent of eligible fees (\$17,904.60). The fee breakdown is as follows: Sewer Benefit Fee @ 50% = \$17,904.60.
