MAYOR'S UPDATE

Ebola Preparedness Update

In response to the recent Ebola outbreak, Orlando has plans in place in the event a need arises. Mayor Dyer introduced Orlando Fire Department Deputy Chief Rich Wales to give a brief update on how OFD is preparing for Ebola. In addition to Deputy Chief Wales, GOAA Executive Director Phil Brown provided a similar update in regard to the Orlando International Airport's preparations.

Deputy Chief Wales was also recognized and congratulated for being named Emergency Medical Services EMS Administrator of the Year by the Orange County EMS Advisory Board. Chief Wales has been very involved in the field of EMS, Health and Safety, and Infection Control for the Orlando Fire Department for many years and Orlando and its citizens are very proud of his accomplishments.

Bond Rating Update

Mayor Dyer introduced Chief Financial Officer Rebecca Sutton to present an update on the City's bond ratings.

Venues Update

This year Orlando has embarked on what might be the most defining year in Downtown Orlando's history. On Thursday October 16, the City broke ground on the new soccer stadium, and next month the City will open its world-class performing arts center and its reconstructed football stadium. Mayor Dyer thanked the Commissioners for their support in making these projects possible and noted that because of their collaboration with the Central Florida community Orlando's Downtown is no longer simply a weekday employment hub, but is now alive with a growing residential population, lively dining and nightlife options, an emerging arts scene, and world-class venues for sports and entertainment.

Houston Visit

Last month Mayor Dyer joined with Orange County Mayor Teresa Jacobs and local community leaders to visit the City of Houston and meet with leaders to better understand how Houston has reduced chronic homelessness by 58% in just three years. After seeing the successful model employed by Houston, there is great optimism that Orlando can also help those who are chronically homeless in our community. Mayor Dyer thanked the Commissioners for their support in continuing to work towards solving the issue of homelessness in Orlando.

National Bullying Prevention Month

The month of October is National Bullying Prevention Month. Approximately one in four students will experience some form of bullying and nearly all students will witness bullying during their years in school. Research shows that bullying can lead to depression, substance abuse, poor health, delinquency and poor academic performance. This week, Orlando will be making an announcement about a new community-wide anti-bullying campaign. Please join Mayor Dyer on Thursday, October 23 at 10 a.m. at the Dr. James R. Smith Neighborhood Center for the special announcement.

Fall Fiesta in the Park

The 44th annual Fall Fiesta in the Park is almost here. On Saturday November 1 and Sunday, November 2, Lake Eola Park will be filled with more than 300 artists and crafters lined around the streets of beautiful Lake Eola Park. The community is invited to this free event which also features great food, live music and a children's play area.

Business and Financial Services Items B-11 and B-12 – SED Agreements

On today's agenda is a developer's agreement for the Sports and Entertainment District Project and an associated lease for the OPD Headquarters while the new headquarters are being constructed. This project is a direct result of the City's public investment in revitalizing Downtown Orlando and Parramore, creating a catalyst for private investment like this. This project, and the redevelopment of this site,

continues to build on the City's efforts to transform Downtown Orlando and continue providing more entertainment and social options for a broad demographic - from families to travelers to people of any age; drawing people downtown and to benefit businesses who have invested in Downtown Orlando's revitalization.

Economic Development Items – Funding Agreements

Also on today's agenda are the annual funding agreements with the City's partner economic development organizations. These organizations leverage their expertise to promote economic growth in the City of Orlando. Through these funding agreements, the City's partner agencies are able to provide technical assistance and educational programming to local entrepreneurs, attract new business investment and promote the City of Orlando to a global audience. Through this capital investment in the community, the City creates jobs for its residents as well as opportunities for small local business owners and entrepreneurs to succeed.

Community Redevelopment Agency Item #4 - Book That Doc.com

On today's agenda is a request to approve a High Wage-High Value job incentive for BookThatDoc.com. This company is currently located in Seminole County and has been seeking a new location to accommodate its future growth. The company plans to relocate 12 employees to Downtown Orlando's Church Street Exchange Building on a temporary basis, with future plans to move to permanent space when a building is available in Orlando's Creative Village. The company will add 38 new jobs over the next three years for a total of 50 new jobs in Downtown Orlando, with a salary 115% above the average annual wage. BookThatDoc.com provides innovative technology and follows in the footsteps of other tech companies that have moved into the Church Street Exchange Building, helping to fuel Downtown Orlando's fast-growing tech industry.
