# MAYOR'S UPDATE

# Orlando City Soccer Hosted First Major League Soccer Game

This past weekend was especially busy in Downtown Orlando. Elton John appeared in concert, the Orlando Magic played twice, the Orlando Ballet performed at the Dr. Philips Downtown Performing Arts Center and the Orlando City Soccer Club hosted its first Major League soccer game in front of a sold out crowd at the Orlando Citrus Bowl. 62,000 people attended the Lions' first game and Purple Pride was everywhere. Church Street was crowded with people enjoying Downtown Orlando and SunRail estimates ridership was in excess of 9,500 people. It is an exciting time for Orlando as the Lions join the Orlando Magic as another great home team major league franchise.

#### **Red Lobster Support Center moves to Orlando**

Last week, Mayor Dyer joined City Commissioners to celebrate the grand opening of the new Red Lobster Support Center in Downtown Orlando. Red Lobster is now one of Downtown Orlando's largest employers, bringing 300 jobs to Orlando's urban core. Next month, Red Lobster plans to open a Culinary Development Center which will bring Red Lobster chefs from around the country to develop new dishes and ideas here in Downtown Orlando.

# Item B-5 - Acquisition of seven (7) multi-family apartment complexes from CAM DISPOSITION HOLDCO LLC

# Item B-7 - Disposition of three (3) multi-family apartment complexes the City is acquiring from CAM DISPOSITION HOLDCO LLC to LIFT ORLANDO, INC.

On today's agenda are proposed plans to purchase seven vacant, foreclosed properties in an effort to redevelop these apartments into safe and attractive housing for residents in Washington Shores and Mercy Drive neighborhoods. These nearly 700 apartment units were foreclosed by Fannie Mae and have been vacant, boarded up and fenced off, creating eyesores within the community and, due to a lack of maintenance over several years, are uninhabitable. The City's purchase of the properties will provide partnership opportunities with developers and community organizations to construct long term, mixed income, affordable housing communities that complement the surrounding neighborhoods.

Also on today's agenda are plans to sell three of these apartment units to LIFT Orlando, a local not-for-profit, which has been working for the last two years with the Washington Shores community to develop a comprehensive revitalization plan that focuses on housing, education, wellness and economic development. LIFT Orlando will partner with The Village of Orlando led by Bishop Allen Wiggins and Columbia Residential to ensure quality redevelopment of the sites and further increase the stability of the neighborhoods.

#### Item D-1 - Fresh Stop Mobile Market Agreement with Hebni Nutrition Consultants

Also on today's agenda is an item that will allow the City to partner with Hebni Nutrition Consultants to provide their Fresh Stop Mobile Market bus at three of Orlando's community centers to provide residents with the opportunity to purchase affordable, high quality fresh food. Mayor Dyer thanked Hebni Nutrition for its partnership, as well as providing access to fresh produce and helping to improve the nutrition and health of Orlando's residents.
