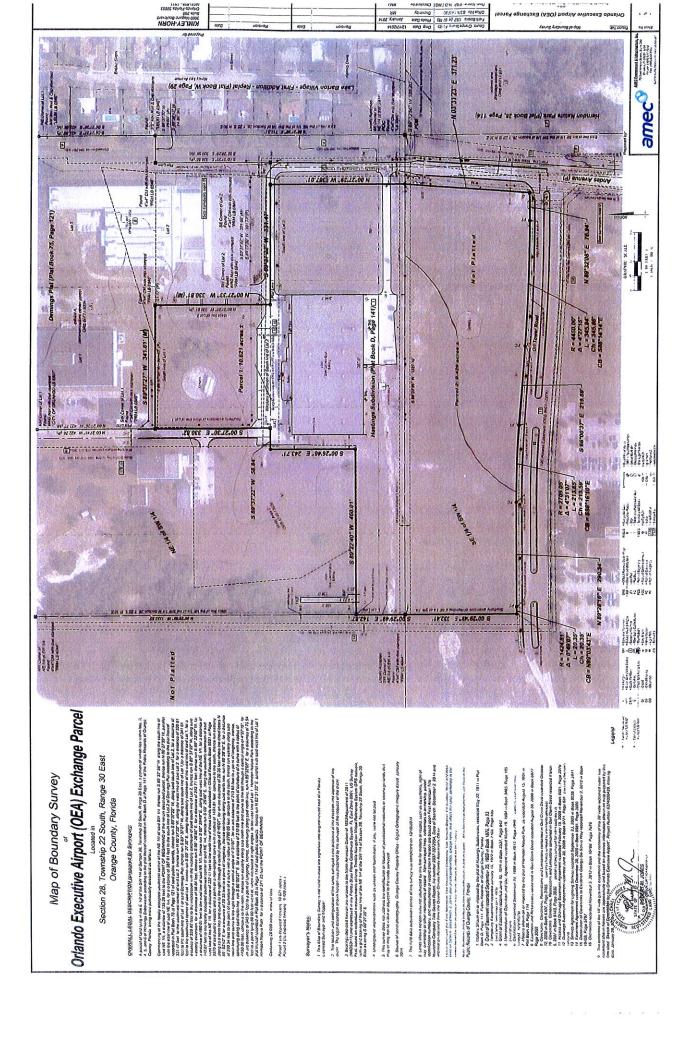

#### DEED OF RELEASE

[AVIATION AUTHORITY FAA PARCEL AT ORLANDO EXECUTIVE AIRPORT]

This instrument, a Deed of Release, made by the United States of America, Acting by and through the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA"), Department of Transportation, under and pursuant to the powers and authority contained in the provisions of 49 U.S.C. § 47153, to the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (the "Aviation Authority"), a public and governmental body existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, and The City of Orlando (the "City"), a Florida Municipal Corporation existing under the laws of the State of Florida (the Aviation Authority and the City hereinafter at some times below collectively referred to as the "Airport Owners").

#### WITNESSNETH:

WHEREAS, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Department of the Navy (the "Grantor") conveyed to the CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA (the "City"), a portion of the property that comprised the Naval Training Center, Orlando ("NTC Orlando"), as further described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof ("Property"), via quitclaim deed entitled "Quitclaim Deed for FAA Herndon Annex Parcel " recorded in Official Records Book 6107, Page 3155, et seq. of the Public Records of Orange County, Florida and "Deed for Early Transfer Portion of Herndon Annex, Study Area 2, FAA Parcel", recorded in Official Records Book 9140, Page 3036, et seq. of the Public Records of Orange County, Florida (the "Deed"); and

WHEREAS, Sections IV through VI of the Deed contain certain terms, restrictions, reservations, covenants, and conditions restricting the use of the Property to public airport purposes which are being released by the grantor, the Department of the Navy in a separate release ("FAA Restrictions"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Property has been included in the Orlando Executive Airport Exhibit "A" Map and Airport Layout Plan and is therefore dedicated to aviation use and encumbered with the FAA Grant Assurances ("FAA Obligations"); and

WHEREAS, the City is fee owner of certain real property located in Orange County, Florida, and incorporated herein by this reference, and which land is to be more particularly described as provided hereinbelow (the "Property"), and aviation Authority occupies and operates the Property as part of Orlando Executive Airport (the "Airport") pursuant to that certain Operation and Use Agreement dated September 27, 1976, as amended (the "Operating Agreement"), with the City; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation Authority, in accordance with the Operating Agreement, has requested the United States of America to release the hereinafter described Property from the Grant Obligations; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of delegation of authority, the Manager, Bart Vernace, Orlando Airports District Office, Airports Division, Southern Region, FAA, under and pursuant to the powers and authority contained in 49 U.S.C. § 47153, is authorized to make determinations on requests for Deed of Release and to execute said Deeds of Release to convey, quitclaim, or release any right or interest reserved to the United States of America by an instrument of disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Manager, Bart Vernace, Orlando Airports District Office, Airports Division, Southern Region, FAA, has determined that the release of such real property as is hereinafter described, from all of the said terms, conditions, reservations and restrictions the FAA Obligations subject to such terms, conditions, reservations, and restrictions, and is necessary to protect or advance the interests of the United States of America in civil aviation, as set forth in the letter from the FAA, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the above expressed recitals and of the benefits to accrue to the United States and to civil aviation, the United States of America, the FAA Obligations are released and terminated with the following restrictions being imposed on the Property:

- (1) The City shall reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns, for the use and benefit of the public, a right of flight for the passage of aircraft in the airspace above the surface of the real property herein described, together with the right to cause in said airspace such noise as may be inherent in the operations of aircraft, now known or hereafter used, for navigation of, or in the said airspace, for use of said airspace for landing on, or taking off from, or operating on Orlando Executive Airport.
- (2) The City expressly agrees for itself, its successors and assigns, to restrict the height of structures, objects of natural growth and other obstructions on the herein described real property to such a height so as to comply with the FAA Regulations, Part 77.
- (3) The City expressly agrees for itself, its successors and assigns, to prevent any use of the herein described real property which would interfere with the landing or takeoff of aircraft at Orlando Executive Airport, or interfere with the air navigation, and
