The Florida Conference Association of Seventh-Day Adventists d/b/a Orlando Junior Academy (OJA), has served the Orlando community since 1906 by offering Pre-K through 8th grade education to approximately 250 annually. OJA will construct an approximately 5400 sf new Kitchen and Culinary Garden, at 28 East King Street, that will serve OJA students and the community, through cooking and gardening while integrating school curriculum, offering an Edible Education Experience. The goal of the Edible Education Experience is to change people's lives by connecting them to the pleasure of growing and preparing food, as well as eating and sharing it.

Total eligible fees for OJA under the Not-for-Profit Impact Fee Assistance Program, are \$16,300.54. The program will pay fifty percent of eligible impact fees (\$8,150.27). The fee breakdown is as follows: Transportation Impact Fee @ 50% = \$6,881.52, Sewer Benefit Fee @ 50% = \$1,268.75.
