This new system will provide increased efficiency for Orlando's public safety teams and help to continue to make Orlando an even safer place to live. The new CAD will move the City's operation to the next level utilizing the new industry standard of next generation 911, the latest mapping technology and an automatic vehicle location system. It has enhanced capabilities that support both Police and Fire operations and will improve functionality, safety, and operational efficiency. The agenda item today is for a specialist to help in a new procurement process that will allow the City to equip the police and fire departments with the best technology while remaining fiscally responsible.

Item H-2 - FY 15-16 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Countywide Award

Orlando works diligently with its residents to prevent and keep crime down and invest in the latest in technology, such as the new CAD system. The City also focuses on solving cases and prosecuting offenders. On today's agenda is an item that will help to further those efforts with grant funding that will allow us to use the latest technology in evidence collection and crime scene reconstruction.
