AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING то OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND **GENERALLY LOCATED NORTH OF WEWAHOOTEE** RD., EAST OF STATE ROAD 417. SOUTH OF STATE ROAD 528. AND WEST OF INTERNATIONAL CORPORATE PARK BLVD., AND COMPRISED OF 2.559 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FINDINGS, AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION, AND FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S OFFICIAL MAPS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2015, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Council"), accepted a petition for voluntary annexation (hereinafter the "petition") bearing the signatures of all owners of property in an area of land generally located north of Wewahootee Road, east of State Road 417, south of State Road 528, and west of International Corporate Park Boulevard, comprised of approximately 2,559 acres of land and being precisely described by the legal description of the area by metes and bounds attached to this ordinance as **Exhibit A** (hereinafter the "property"); and

WHEREAS, the petition was filed with the Orlando City Council pursuant to section 171.044, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of November 17, 2015, the Municipal Planning Board (the "MPB") of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "city"), considered annexation case numbers ANX2015-00013, ANX2015-00019, and ANX2015-00020 (the "applications"), requesting to annex the property into the jurisdictional boundaries of the city; and

WHEREAS, based upon the evidence presented to the MPB, including the information and analysis contained in the "Staff Report to the Municipal Planning Board" for application case numbers ANX2015-00013, ANX2015-00019, and ANX2015-00020, GMP2015-00038, GMP2015-00039, and ZON2015-00033 (entitled "Item #1 – Starwood Annexation"), the MPB recommended that the Orlando City Council approve said applications and adopt an ordinance or ordinances in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds that:

- 2. As of the date of the petition, the property is contiguous to the city within the meaning of subsection 171.031(11), Florida Statutes; and
