A meeting of the City of Orlando Certification Board was held on Wednesday, January 27, 2016, at City Hall, 400 S. Orange Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Agenda Conference Room, Orlando, Florida 32801.

Board Members Present: Brikena Tomasic, Chairperson [4,1], Charles Hawkins II [4,1], Bruno Portigliatti, Vice Chairperson [4,0], Khalid Muneer [4,2] and Ramesh Panchal [4,2].

Board Members Absent: Mi Hoshino [4,1] and Maria G. Turk [4,2].

Staff Members Present: Kevin Walsh, MBE Official, Gina Bernard, Certification Officer, III and Grace M. Gyorko, Recording Secretary.

The Board convened at 8:30 a.m., Brikena Tomasic, Chairperson, called the Certification Board meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

The minutes from the December 16, 2015 Board meeting were approved as written.

#### M/WBE RULINGS

<u>Pileum Corp.</u> – Jill Beneke, President/ CEO, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigliatti, seconded by Khalid Muneer and vote carried unanimously to deny WBE status to Pileum Corp. based on:

- 1. The business concern must be at least 51% owned by minority group members or at least 51% owned by women group members, as characterized by:
  - a) Independent contribution of capital by the minority or the women group members commensurate with percent of ownership claimed. Ownership gifted to minority or women owners, equipment or other assets gifted, and/or funds gifted to purchase ownership or to establish a new business will not be considered independent contributions of capital. Inherited capital or assets will not be considered as gifted for purposes of these rules. Expertise will not be considered capital for the purposes of these rules.
- 2. The minority or the women owner(s) must possess independent power to direct or cause direction of management and policies of the firm, as characterized by:
  - a) Substantial experience in firm's line(s) of business for which minority and/or women-owned business status is requested.
- 3. The company is not considered an independent women-owned enterprise because the husband and/or other male principal:
  - a) Provides the expertise to perform line(s) of business or has the greater experience in the industry.

The applicant was advised of her right to appeal the Board's decision.

<u>Metrix Solutions.</u> – Jill Beneke, President /CEO, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Khalid Muneer, seconded by Bruno Portigliatti and vote carried unanimously to deny WBE status to Metrix Solutions based on:

A company must provide a commercially useful function within the normal industry practices, as characterized by:

- 1. Suppliers must demonstrate that it is a "regular dealer" of the commodities for which M/WBE status is requested, as characterized by:
  - a) Owns, operates, or maintains a store, warehouse or other establishment in which commodities or goods of the general character as those identified in the M/WBE application are brought, kept in stock, and sold to the public in the usual course of business.
  - b) Has an established or leased or assigned space in which it regularly maintains a stock of goods in which it claims to be a supplier/distributor.
  - c) While not required that all sales be made from stock, the Company must maintain a stock of goods of the general character as those identified on the M/WBE Application, and as a regular course of business dealings, makes sales from such stock.
- 2. The firm has not demonstrated that it is a functioning business enterprise which:
- a) Demonstrates the capability (i.e., employees, equipment, facilities, supplies, etc.) to perform a line of business.
- b) Provides a commercially useful business function according to customs and practices of the industry.

The applicant was advised of her right to appeal the Board's decision.

Charles Hawkins II left the meeting at 9:35 a.m.

<u>TLP Engineering Consultants, Inc.</u> – Yassi Myers, President, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigliatti, seconded by Ramesh Panchal and vote carried unanimously to re-certify TLP Engineering Consultants, Inc. as a WBE Civil Engineering Consulting Services.

<u>Diversified Supply, Inc.</u> – George Urquida, President, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigiliatti, seconded by Khalid Muneer and vote carried unanimously to re-certify Diversified Supply, Inc. as an MBE Supplier- Electrical Lighting Fixtures, Lamps and Safety Supplies.

<u>ABC Landclearing & Development.</u> - James Goins, Vice-President, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigliatti, seconded by Khalid Muneer and vote carried unanimously to re-certify ABC Landclearing & Development as an MBE Landclearing, Site Work, Excavation, Demolition, Concrete Work and Hauling Earth Materials.

Nebbia Technology, LLC. – Esteban Garcia, President, appeared before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigliatti, seconded by Ramesh Panchal and vote carried unanimously to certify Nebbia Technology, LLC as an MBE Software Development and Consulting.

<u>BLC Partners, LLC.</u> The applicant did not appear before the Board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Bruno Portigliatti, seconded by Khalid Muneer and vote carried unanimously to deny WBE status to BLC Partners, LLC based on:

- 1) The business concern must be at least 51% owned by minority group members or at least 51% owned by women group members, as characterized by:
  - a) Independent contribution of capital by the minority or the women group members commensurate with percent of ownership claimed. Ownership gifted to minority or women owners, equipment or other assets gifted, and/or funds gifted to purchase ownership or to establish a new business will not be considered independent contributions of capital. Inherited capital or assets will not be considered as gifted for purposes of these rules. Expertise will not be considered capital for the purposes of these rules.
- 2) The minority or the women owner(s) must possess independent power to direct or cause direction of management and policies of the firm for which minority and/or women-owned business status is requested, as characterized by:
  - a) Possess independent authority and ability to incur liabilities for the firm and make all financial and policy decisions (commensurate with ownership).
  - b) Possesses independent authority to hire/fire management personnel.
- 3) The company is not considered an independent women-owned enterprise because the husband and/or other male principal:
  - a) Is Chief Executive Officer or President.
  - b) Possesses equal or greater powers to direct management and day-to-day decisions.

Architecture Studio, Inc. - The applicant did not appear before the board. Discussion ensued. It was moved by Brikena Tomasic, seconded by Bruno Portigliatti and vote carried unanimously to certify Architecture Studio, Inc. as an MBE Architectural and Interior Design Service Firm.

#### Re-Certifications

<u>Carmen Dominguez Contruction, LLC.</u> – The applicant did not appear before the Board. (Brikena Tomasic presented a Memorandum of Voting Conflicts – Form 8b). Discussion ensued. The decision to re-certify Carmen Dominguez Construction, LLC was tabled pending a quorum of voting members present.

## WHO MUST FILE FORM 8B

This form is for use by any person serving at the county, city, or other local level of government on an appointed or elected board, council, commission, authority, or committee. It applies equally to members of advisory and non-advisory bodies who are presented with a voting conflict of interest under Section 112.3143. Florida Statutes.

Your responsibilities under the law when faced with voting on a measure in which you have a conflict of interest will vary greatly depending on whether you hold an elective or appointive position. For this reason, please pay close attention to the instructions on this form before completing the reverse side and filing the form.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 112.3143, FLORIDA STATUTES

A person holding elective or appointive county, municipal, or other local public office MUST ABSTAIN from voting on a measure which inures to his or her special private gain or loss. Each elected or appointed local officer also is prohibited from knowingly voting on a measure which inures to the special gain or loss of a principal (other than a government agency) by whom he or she is retained (including the parent organization or subsidiary of a corporate principal by which he or she is retained); to the special private gain or loss of a relative; or to the special private gain or loss of a business associate. Commissioners of community redevelopment agencies under Sec. 163.356 or 163.357, F.S., and officers of independent special tax districts elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis are not prohibited from voting in that capacity.

However, you must disclose the nature of the conflict before making any attempt to influence the decision, whether orally or in writing and whether made by you or at your direction.
