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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AND THE BOARD OF **DIRECTORS** OF THE **DOWNTOWN** SOUTH **NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT** DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022 BUDGET FOR DOWNTOWN SOUTH **NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT** DISTRICT; PROVIDING CERTAIN FINDINGS: **PROVIDING** CERTAIN BUDGET ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES: **PROVIDING FOR** CORRECTION OF **SCRIVENER'S** SEVERABILITY. ERRORS, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Downtown South Neighborhood Improvement District (the "district") was created and chartered on July 25, 2011, by City of Orlando Ordinance #2011-28; and

WHEREAS, the district was created and chartered pursuant to the Safe Neighborhoods Act, codified at Part IV, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, and the Orlando Neighborhood Improvement District Code, codified at Chapter 40, Code of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Code"); and

**WHEREAS**, the district is a "local government neighborhood improvement district" pursuant to and as described at section 163.506, Florida Statutes, and sections 40.4(1)(a) and 40.11, Orlando City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the district is a "dependent special district" within the meaning of the Uniform Special District Accountability Act, codified at Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, and for the purposes of preparing and considering tentative and final budgets, and adopting a final budget, pursuant to Chapter 200, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the district is authorized by section 163.506(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and section 40.14(1), Orlando City Code, to levy an ad valorem tax on real and personal property of up to 2 mills annually, and by subsection 163.514(5), Florida Statutes, to have exclusive control of funds legally available to it; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to subsection 163.5151(1), Florida Statutes, and an agreement between the City of Orlando, Florida (the "City") and the district, all funds of the district are received, held, and secured in the same manner as other public funds by the Chief Financial Officer of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the district's board of directors is the governing board of the district (the "board of directors") and is comprised of the members of the Orlando City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the board of directors has, upon recommendation of the Downtown South Neighborhood Improvement District Advisory Council (the "Advisory Council"), approved a proposed district budget for fiscal year 2021/2022 ("FY 2021/2022") and the budget will be included in the City of Orlando's budget document; and

**WHEREAS**, the district's fiscal year begins on October 1, and ends on September 30; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed budget includes the estimated expenditures necessary to carry out the functions of the district for FY2021/2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, and the board of directors have examined and carefully considered the proposed budget in duly assembled, properly noticed, public meetings; and

**WHEREAS**, the board of directors and the Orlando City Council hereby certify compliance with the provisions of Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, and other applicable laws, rules, and procedures; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DOWNTOWN SOUTH NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. PREAMBLE.** The "whereas clauses" contained hereinabove are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this resolution as if fully set forth hereinafter.

**SECTION 2. BUDGET ADOPTED.** The annual budget for the district for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2021, and ending on September 30, 2022, attached to this resolution as **Schedule "A"** (the "budget"), is hereby confirmed, adopted, and approved in all respects. The budget is adopted after full, complete, and comprehensive public hearings. We hereby find that the budget is necessary to provide required funds for capital outlays, operating expenses, expenditures for materials, labor, equipment, supplies, and contingent expenses of the district. The budget represents and presents the judgment and intent of the board of directors as to the needs of the district.

**SECTION 3. BUDGET ACCOUNTING.** The budget has been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

**SECTION 4. REVENUES.** The revenues estimated for receipt by the district during FY2021/2022, from all sources, and any amounts carried over from prior fiscal years, equals the total of appropriations for expenditures and reserves in the budget.

**SECTION 5. EXPENDITURES.** The budget, as such budget may be amended from time to time, will govern expenditures of the district and no expenditures shall be made, nor contracts for expenditures be entered into except in pursuance of budget appropriations.

**SECTION 6. SPECIAL DISTRICT BUDGET PROCEDURES.** The budget is adopted in accordance with section 189.016, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 7. CLOSEOUT OF BOOKS. To provide an orderly year-end closeout of all financial books and records of the district, the City's Chief Financial Officer, on behalf of and subject to the direction of the board of directors, is hereby authorized and directed, as needed, to increase the corresponding line item appropriations in the budget to the extent of those purchase orders which shall have been issued prior to September 30, 2021, but which have not been filled prior to that date, and is authorized and directed to pay all such purchase orders upon receipt of the goods or services therein specified from the funds so appropriated. The City's Chief Financial Officer is hereby further authorized and directed to increase the appropriate budget line items to include any unexpended balances as of the end of business on September 30, 2021, from federal, state, or other grants that were previously authorized by the district, and to the extent of any unexpended balances from the prior fiscal year's budget, as amended, whether or not encumbered, outstanding in projects as of the end of business on September 30. 2021, and all such balances shall be appropriated to the corresponding accounts in the same funds in which they were outstanding as of September 30, 2021. The City's Chief Financial Officer is also hereby authorized and directed to expend such appropriations for the purposes approved by the district in connection with federal, state, or other grants and projects. Corresponding changes in the anticipated revenue accounts are hereby authorized.

**SECTION 8. CERTAIN LINE ITEM TRANSFERS AUTHORIZED.** The City's Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer appropriations from one line item to another line item of the budget, upon approval of the chairperson of the board of directors, or designee, so long as the total appropriations are not increased or decreased thereby. Transactions affecting total appropriations, other than those authorized herein shall require the prior approval of the board of directors. Any such transactions are subject to applicable Florida statutes, regulations, and local laws.

**SECTION 9. BUDGET CHANGES.** All changes to the budget made by the City's Chief Financial Officer, other than correction of errors, shall be reported to the board of directors on at least a quarterly basis. As required by subsection 189.016(6), Florida Statutes, the board of directors shall adopt a final adjusted budget, including any amendments made during the year, within 60 days following the end of the fiscal year.

**SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this resolution or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect

134	invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are
135	severable.
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137	SECTION 11. SCRIVENER'S ERROR. The City Attorney may correct scrivener's
138	errors found in this resolution by filing a corrected copy of this resolution with the City
139	Clerk.
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141	SECTION 12. REPEAL. All resolutions or parts of resolutions previously adopted
142	and in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.
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144	SECTION 13. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution takes effect immediately upon
145	adoption.
