MAYOR'S UPDATE

LYNX Grapefruit Line Service

Last week, following the State of the City given by Mayor Dyer, the Mayor joined with City Commissioners, LYNX and the FTA to kick-off the new LYMMO Grapefruit Line service. This 3.5 mile, east-west expansion of the fare-free downtown circulator will provide another critical link for transit users to connect to SunRail, and continue the City's focus on making Orlando a more pedestrian-friendly destination by expanding public transportation options. The Grapefruit Line expansion will serve 15 stations and new destinations, including the Thornton Park and Parramore neighborhoods, Publix, County Administration and Health Department, and the Federal Courthouse. The Grapefruit Line is one more important piece in the transit system that will help connect SunRail riders throughout Downtown Orlando.

City Elections Update

Mayor Dyer gave an update on the Orlando City Council District 5 election last Tuesday, April 8. Candidates Regina Hill and Edward "Juan" Lynum will go to a runoff election. Voters in City Council District 5 will have an opportunity to vote in the runoff on Tuesday, May 6, 2014. Early Voting begins Monday, April 28, 2014 and ends Sunday, May 4, 2014. Item B-3 – Advisory Committee Ranking for Design Build Services of Orlando Police Department Headquareters

On today's agenda is an item that move forward the design and construction of the new Orlando Police Department Headquarters. A new headquarters would give OPD a modern home that is more accessible to the City's residents and that allows the city to continue giving its residents the benefits of technology-based policing. The new police headquarters will replace the outdated building that exists today, funded in large part by savings created by Orlando's Green Works Orlando initiative.

Item C-5 – PowerDMS Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Resolution

On today's agenda is a Qualified Target Industry agreement to support the expansion of PowerDMS, a tech company headquartered in Downtown Orlando. The company currently has 46 employees and has plans to create an additional 65 high-wage jobs if this incentive is approved. Orlando was recently named one of America's most promising tech hubs. In Mayor Dyer's State of the City address, he talked about the importance of fostering Orlando's tech community so that it continues to attract more tech companies and helps those companies to expand which continues to validate Orlando as a high-tech hub with top-tier talent.

Item H-1 – Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation Program Grant

On today's agenda is an application for a grant that will assist the Orlando Police Department in reducing crime and improving community safety as part of a comprehensive strategy to advance neighborhood

revitalization. If the grant is received, the funding will be used to implement crime fighting initiatives and provide additional services to the Rosemont neighborhood of Orlando.
