Discovery Education Services, Inc. d/b/a Orlando Science Schools (OSS) is a Florida not-for-profit organization that has operated Orlando Science Elementary School and Orlando Science Middle/High School since 2008. OSS is a tuition-free Orange County public charter school, with an emphasis on science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education. OSS is the "home base" for more than 800 diverse Central Florida students.

the City, including reductions in personnel or actual cost (cash flow) reductions to be realized in your budget.

With its focus on STEM, OSS has a waiting list and demand for a larger facility. Its current elementary school campus consists of portables at 2427 Lynx Lane. The school is working to secure funds to complete interior renovation of an existing 31,101 sf, two story office building at 2611 Technology Drive to accommodate 400 students. Total capital investment for this project is approximately \$1.4 million.

Total eligible fees for OSS under the Not-for-Profit Impact Fee Assistance Program, are \$44,071.89. The program will pay fifty percent of eligible impact fees (\$22,035.65). The fee breakdown is as follows: Sewer Benefit Fee @ 50% = \$22,035.65.
