A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR A TEN (10) YEAR EXEMPTION FROM THAT PORTION OF AD VALOREM TAXATION LEVIED BY THE CITY OF ORLANDO ON ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE INCREASE IN ASSESSED VALUE RESULTING FROM RENOVATION OF AN HISTORIC STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 500 S. ORANGE AVE., IN ORLANDO, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**WHEREAS,** Section 196.1997, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 65, Part 8, Orlando City Code, establish a procedure for requesting a partial exemption from ad valorem taxes for historic real property that has been the subject of a qualifying renovation, restoration, or other improvement; and

**WHEREAS,** the City's Historic Preservation Officer has certified that the real property described in the Legal Description shown in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Property") is addressed as 500 S. Orange Ave., Orlando, Florida 32801; and

**WHEREAS,** the City's Historic Preservation Officer has certified that the Property is improved by a commercial structure that is designated an Orlando Historic Landmark; and

**WHEREAS,** the owner of the Property, GDC Orlando Hotel Owner, LLC (the "Owner"), has completed a renovation of the historic structure located on the Property and has submitted an application for the ad valorem tax exemption, as shown in Exhibit "B," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida hereby finds and determines that the Owner's renovation of the historic structure on the Property is eligible for exemption, pursuant to Section 196.1997, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 65, Part 8, Orlando City Code; and

**WHEREAS,** the Owner has executed an Historic Preservation Tax Exemption Covenant, as shown in Exhibit "C," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Covenant"), which requires that the Owner maintain the character of the Property and the qualifying improvements during the period of the tax exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, that the above recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth below; and

49	the Property is hereby exempt from that portion of ad valorem taxation levied by the City of	
50	Orlando on one hundred percent (100%) of the increase in assessed value resulting from the	
51	renovation of the historic structure located at 500 S. Orange Ave. for a period of ten (10)	
52	consecutive years commencing January 1, 2014 and expiring December 31, 2023, provided that	
53	the Owner complies with the requirements	of the Covenant; and
