- I. CALL TO ORDER  
Chair Alana C. Brenner called the meeting to order at 3:10 p.m.
  
  - II. CONSIDERATION OF CANVASSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF MAY 6, 2014  
The Canvassing Board reviewed the Canvassing Board Meeting Minutes of May 6, 2014. It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous to accept the Canvassing Board Meeting Minutes of May 6, 2014.
  
  - III. CONSIDERATION OF PRECINCT RESULTS – COMPARISON OF TAPES  
The Canvassing Board reviewed the tapes from the run-off election held on May 6, 2014 and Chair Alana C. Brenner advised that she had compared them to the results sheets and they matched.
  
  - IV. CONSIDERATION OF PROVISIONAL BALLOTS  
Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff members Jeanette Johnson, Donna Peterson and Pat Heflin presented two (2) provisional ballots for review by the Canvassing Board:

Tanishia Starr – Precinct 5401 - Rejected

Ms. Starr attempted to vote at the polling place but the polling place staff did not allow her to cast her vote at the precinct because she is ineligible to vote as a result of a felony conviction. Ms. Starr was allowed to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Ms. Johnson and Ms. Peterson presented the sealed provisional ballot to the Canvassing Board. It was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, to reject the provisional ballot as the voter is ineligible to vote, and vote was unanimous to REJECT the ballot.

Leonard Stark – Precinct 5301 - Accepted

Mr. Stark's absentee ballot was received by the Supervisor of Elections Office unsigned, and was rejected by the Canvassing Board as reflected in the Canvassing Board Minutes of May 6, 2014 (p.2). However, Mr. Stark attempted to vote at the polling place and was informed that his vote had already been counted as a result of the returned absentee ballot, but he was allowed to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Ms. Heflin presented the sealed provisional ballot to the Canvassing Board. Commissioner Patty Sheehan moved to accept the provisional ballot, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and discussion ensued. The provisional ballot was tabled by the Canvassing Board for review by Amy Iennaco. After review and further discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, seconded by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, and vote was unanimous to REJECT the absentee ballot and ACCEPT the provisional ballot based on the provisions of Fla. Stat. §101.69. The provisional ballot was stamped "Accepted" on the outside of the envelope, was opened and was run through the tabulating machine.

V. CONSIDERATION OF ANY OUT-STACKED PRECINCT BALLOTS

There were no out-stacked precinct ballots for the Canvassing Board to consider.

VI. CONSIDERATION OF FINAL TOTALS AND DISCUSSION OF CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION

Staff member Luis Torres informed the Canvassing Board that one (1) early voting provisional ballot went into the count of absentee ballots, but that the error did not result in any change in the total number of votes cast or the results. Based on the additional provisional ballot being accepted as noted above concerning Mr. Stark, one vote was added to the votes in Precinct 5301. It was moved by Commissioner Tony Ortiz, seconded by Commissioner Patty Sheehan, and vote was unanimous to accept the final totals and certify the election. The final certified results are attached to these minutes.

VII. AUDIT

In accordance with F.S. 101.591, Voting System audit, the Canvassing Board randomly selected Precinct 5401 and a manual audit was performed in accordance with the procedures required by law. A manual count of election ballots by the members of the Canvassing Board resulted in the following:


