1. DESCRIPTION: In Spring of FY 2013-2014, the City of Orlando is awarding a total of \$50,000 through the Mayor's Matching Grant program. This represents awards ranging from \$3,500 to \$7,000 to 10 neighborhood organizations, schools and 501(c)3 non-profit organizations. City of Orlando neighborhood organizations are awarded grants in increments of \$500 to \$5,000 for neighborhood improvement projects in areas of educational, cultural, public safety or physical improvement or enhancements projects that address neighborhood needs, improve education and build community pride. Schools and tax-exempt 501(c)3 non-profit organizations are awarded grants in increments of \$1,000 to \$10,000 and are encouraged to partner with neighborhood organizations, community groups and business partners to offer programs that engage our City's youth in constructive, adult supervised activities during non-school hours. The appropriation request serves the best interests of the City of Orlando and would not violate any local, state or federal law or state or federal constitutional provision.
