12. JUSTIFICATION: Document justification for request. The City operates an after school program and summer camp at OHA's Citrus Square Apartments, attended by approximately 65 children, 98% low income. The children use a playground and basketball court adjacent to the Site. Over time, these amenities have fallen into disrepair and, due to funding limitations, OHA has not been in a position to renovate them.

In addition, the Site is too small to adequately serve the large number of children enrolled. The beneficiaries of this Agreement are the children who reside at Citrus Square Apartments and attend the City's programs there.
