2014 Municipal Equality Index

Mayor Dyer announced that the City of Orlando obtained the highest possible score of 100 on the 2014 Municipal Equality Index, a nationwide evaluation of 353 cities conducted by the Equality Federation Institute and Human Rights Campaign Foundation. The Municipal Equality Index ranks cities on how inclusive the city's laws and policies are for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community (LGBT). Mayor Dyer thanked Commissioner Sheehan for leading this effort. Orlando is one of the major cities in the country to obtain the top score on this report. It demonstrates the progress our community has made and validates Orlando's commitment to have an inclusive government that embraces diversity and implements policies to benefit all sectors of society, including the LGBT community.

Orlando Citrus Bowl Dedication and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

This week Downtown Orlando will celebrate the opening of the new Orlando Citrus Bowl. Mayor Dyer invited everyone to join the community to honor the historic past of this stadium and to usher in a new era. The official Citrus Bowl Dedication and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony event starts at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 19 followed by the Citrus Bowl's first event, the annual Florida Blue Florida Classic on Saturday, November 22.

State of Downtown

On December 3 at 3:30 p.m. Mayor Dyer will deliver his annual State of Downtown Address and share the latest on the City's comprehensive visioning process for the continued revitalization of Downtown Orlando. This year's address will be given at the historic Church Street Exchange building, which has recently been brought back to life and is now filled with technology start-ups that are fueling Orlando's next generation economy. Opening of Park of the Americas

On Saturday, November 22, Mayor Dyer will join District 2 Commissioner Tony Ortiz for a ribbon cutting ceremony to re-open the Park of the Americas, a 28-acre park that was previously closed due to damage caused by hurricanes in 2004. The newly renovated park will include the first off-leash Dog Park in the city, walking paths, gathering areas, benches, game tables, picnic areas and more.
