

Board Purpose

The Criminal Nuisance Abatement Board was established by City Ordinance on January 11, 1998. The Board consists of five members appointed by the mayor. Their purpose is to hear complaints regarding drug-related or prostitution-related public nuisances, youth and street gang activity. The Board also has the power to levy fines and request foreclosure, if necessary. The board works closely with Representatives of the Orlando Police Department. The cases are initiated by the Police Department staff. Property owners who fail to come into compliance after being issued a notice by the Police Department are then presented to the Criminal Nuisance Abatement Board.


Many notices have been mailed out to the property owners since the Board's inception. Most of the complaints are resolved without the necessity of a hearing.

Report of Activities

During this past fiscal year, the board continued to monitor the cases which had signed consent agreements with the Board. There were two meetings and staff presented an overview of the cases being monitored while under the Board's jurisdiction.

Major initiatives or Significant Accomplishments

This Board has witnessed a significant decrease in violators overall, compared to prior year's reports. Currently, there are no pending cases.
