- **WHEREAS,** the American Red Cross was founded in 1881 by Clara Barton, a woman selflessly devoted to the needs of humanity; and
- WHEREAS, chartered and authorized by Congress to act in times of need, the Red Cross provides relief to victims of disasters and helps people prevent, prepare for, and respond to emergencies; and
- WHEREAS, the American Red Cross of Central Florida was established in 1917; and
- WHEREAS, more than 900 Red Cross volunteers from Central Florida responded to 625 local disasters and numerous national disasters last year—providing food, clothing, shelter, medications, recovery planning, and mental health support; and
- **WHEREAS,** people have counted on the Red Cross for the information and skills they need to be safe at home, at work, at school, and at play; and
- WHEREAS, last year the American Red Cross of Central Florida trained 19,860 people in lifesaving CPR, in the use of automated external defibrillators (AEDS), first aid, and aquatic lifesaving procedures; and
- WHEREAS, American Red Cross staff deploy with the U.S. military to provide emergency communications and a caring presence to service men and women separated from their families; and
- **WHEREAS,** in March of 1943, President Franklin Delano Roosevelt called upon the American people to rededicate themselves to the aims and activities of the Red Cross;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, I, BUDDY DYER,** Mayor of the City of Orlando, do hereby Proclaim the month of March 2015 as

"AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH"

in the City of Orlando.
