

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE I, CHAPTER 35 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ENTITLED "LAKES AND BOATING," BY AMENDING SECTIONS 35.01 AND 35.06 TO CLARIFY THE INTENT, AND BY ADDING SECTION 35.081; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE.** Article I, Chapter 35, Code of the City of Orlando, Florida, is hereby amended as follows:

**SEC. 35.01. DAMAGE TO LAKE BANKS.**

No person shall ~~dig or delve into~~ dig, scrape, mar or in anywise injure the publicly owned banks of any lake ~~for worms, or dig, scrape, mar or in anywise injure~~ or disturb the margin of such lakes at any time for any purpose, without first obtaining written permission from the City Council.

**SEC. 35.06. CONTAMINATION OF WATER PROHIBITED.**

No person shall ~~throw~~ deposit into any lake or waterbody any ~~vegetable or animal matter~~ man made or natural material, or other thing, that will contaminate the water of such lake or waterbody.

**SEC. 35.081. AQUATIC PLANT MANAGEMENT IN CITY LAKES.**

The City of Orlando follows the rules and guidelines set forth in the State of Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission's Permit Rules in Chapter 68F-20, with the exception of 68F-20.0035(d). Although no permit will be issued by the City of Orlando for any aquatic plant management in lakes less than 10 acres, any aquatic plant management that occurs in those lakes less than 10 acres shall not negatively impact said lakes' water quality.

**SECTION TWO. CODIFICATION.** The City Clerk and the City Attorney shall cause the Code of the City of Orlando, Florida, to be amended as provided by this ordinance and may renumber, re-letter, and rearrange the codified parts of this ordinance if necessary to facilitate the finding of the law.

**SECTION THREE. SCRIVENER'S ERROR.** The City Attorney may correct scrivener's errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the City Clerk.

**SECTION FOUR. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the

invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

**SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance takes effect upon adoption.
