

- WHEREAS, from 2010 to 2012, an estimated 17,400 intentionally set fires in residential buildings were reported to U.S. fire departments each year, resulting in 275 civilian deaths, 800 civilian injuries and \$513 million in property loss; and
- **WHEREAS,** over the last five years, there have been an average of 53,127 arsons reported with an average dollar loss of \$15,086 per incident; and
- WHEREAS, in the City of Orlando, there are four full-time investigators assigned to the Orlando Fire Department Arson/Bomb Squad; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Orlando Fire Department Arson/Bomb Squad was instrumental in the development of a multi-disciplined Arson Task Force during a series of 28 suspicious arson related fires throughout Central Florida in 2014; and
- WHEREAS, the Orlando Fire Department Arson/Bomb Squad has consistently held an arrest and apprehension rate that is three times the national average for the crime of arson, and
- WHEREAS, the Orlando Fire Department Arson/Bomb Squad continues to be one of the few fire department-based squads in the country that is tasked with full authority for arson and bomb-related investigative functions, working under the authority and training of the Orlando Police Department for law enforcement actions; and
- WHEREAS, accelerant detection canines are used by the Orlando Fire Department Arson/Bomb Squad and Orlando Police Department as motivated, accelerant detection tools who help save time and money; and
- WHEREAS, accelerant detection canines are important community members as they work and live with a handler, law enforcement officer or firefighter trained to investigate fire scenes, close more cases resulting in a reduction of arson problems and add to the community's fire prevention and education program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City of Orlando recognizes all fire and law enforcement investigative agencies and detection canines for their dedication and tireless services;
