For individuals who conduct lobbying activities with Aviation Authority employees or Board members, registration with the Aviation Authority is required each year prior to conducting any lobbying activities. A statement of expenditures incurred in connection with those lobbying instances should also be filed prior to April 1 of each year for the preceding year. As of January 16, 2013, lobbying any Aviation Authority Staff who are members of any committee responsible for ranking Proposals, Letters of Interest, Statements of Qualifications or Bids and thereafter forwarding those recommendations to the Board and/or Board Members is prohibited from the time that a Request for Proposals, Request for Letters of Interests, Request for Qualifications or Request for Bids is released to the time that the Board makes an award. As adopted by the Board on September 19, 2012, lobbyists are now required to sign-in at the Aviation Authority offices prior to any meetings with Staff or Board members. In the event a lobbyist meets with or otherwise communicates with Staff or a Board member at a location other than the Aviation Authority offices, the lobbyist shall file a Notice of Lobbying (Form 4) detailing each instance of lobbying to the Aviation Authority within 7 calendar days of such lobbying. As of January 16, 2013, Lobbyists will also provide a notice to the Aviation Authority when meeting with the Mayor of the City of Orlando or the Mayor of Orange County at their offices. ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation to Dispose of Surplus Property

BACKGROUND

The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority is permitted to dispose of property that is no longer necessary, useful or profitable.

ISSUES

The Airport Facilities Bond Resolution and Aviation Authority Policies and Procedures Sections 450.05 and 450.11, permit the Aviation Authority to dispose of property, for fair and reasonable value at any time, any property constituting part of the Airport System which the Aviation Authority and City determine, by Resolution, not necessary, useful or profitable.

The Aviation Authority Staff recommends disposal of property items as summarized below, in accordance with Aviation Authority policies.

- Electronic equipment
- · Assorted chairs, desks, cabinets, bookcases and tables
- Hotel equipment
- Miscellaneous equipment

ALTERNATIVES

The Aviation Authority could hold the property for future disposal.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation of the Construction Committee to Approve an Addendum to the Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with Prime Construction Group, Inc. for Construction Services for Project H260, Repairs to Enplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design-Build) at the Orlando International Airport

BACKGROUND

Project H260, Repairs to Emplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design-Build) at the Orlando International Airport, provides for the design and construction for the structural repair of Pier Cap No. 5 on both A and B Sides with temporary supports, attachment of new structural steel components, and the replacement of 13 new diaphragms on both A and B sides. The scope also includes Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) and relocation of roadway lights.

Construction is scheduled to start in April 2015 and complete in July 2015.

ISSUES

The Aviation Authority's Policy 130.01 (Construction Contracts and Changes) provides that when it is in the best interest of the Aviation Authority to utilize a Continuing Contract for construction projects, the Aviation Authority may seek bids, proposals or a directly-negotiated construction contract addendum, on a competitive or noncompetitive basis, without public announcement (advertisement), in accordance with Section 255.103 of the Florida Statutes. Due to the critical nature and timeliness of Project H260, the scope was directly-negotiated with Prime Construction Group, Inc. under its Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with the Aviation Authority.

Prime Construction Group, Inc. has proposed a direct-negotiated lump sum amount of \$409,112 for construction services for Project H260. Prime Construction Group, Inc.'s pricing has been reviewed and determined to be reasonable and the scope has been verified.

The Director of Small Business Development has reviewed the bid from Prime Construction Group, Inc. and determined that Prime Construction Group, Inc. proposes to achieve 6.03% MWBE participation and that Prime Construction Group, Inc. is eligible for award of this contract.

On March 31, 2015, the Construction Committee recommended the approval of an Addendum to the Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with Prime Construction Group, Inc. for the construction services for Project H260, Repairs to Emplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design-Build) at the Orlando International Airport, for a lump sum amount of \$409,112, subject to the Aviation Authority Board's approval of project funding.

The total project cost of Project H260 is approximately \$460,000 (which includes the construction amount of \$409,112 plus construction phase Owner's Authorized Representative (OAR) services, and project contingency). Funding in the not-to-exceed amount of \$460,000 is needed from Airport Facilities Renewal and Replacement Funds to proceed with Project H260. Approval by the Aviation Authority Board is required to include this expenditure in the Aviation Authority's current year budget.

ALTERNATIVES

There are no reasonable alternatives under consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is \$460,000. Funding is from Airport Facilities Renewal and Replacement Funds.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to accept the recommendation of the Construction Committee and (1) approve an Addendum to the Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with Prime Construction Group, Inc. for construction services for Project H260, Repairs to Enplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design-Build) at the Orlando International Airport for the direct-negotiated lump sum amount of \$409,112 with funding from Airport Facilities Renewal and Replacement Funds; (2) approve the use of Airport Facilities Renewal and Replacement Funds in a not-to-exceed amount of \$460,000 for Project H260, Repairs to Enplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design-Build) at the Orlando International Airport; (3) request Orlando City Council concurrence to include this expenditure in the Aviation Authority's current year budget; and (4) authorize an Aviation Authority Officer or the Executive Director to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel.

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Mr. Patterson asked about the completion date, and Mr. Roche answered that it is anticipated to be completed by the end of April 2015. Mr. Patterson further asked if these services will be designed with the flexibility for replacement of LED light fixtures in the future, and Mr. Roche answered yes.

Upon motion of Mr. Devine, second by Ms. Churchill, vote carried to approve a Job Order Construction Services Addendum to the Continuing Signage Construction Services Agreement with International Signs & Lighting, Inc. for G022, for a direct-negotiated lump sum amount of \$101,304.00, and waive the requirement for Performance and Payment Bonds, with funding from Passenger Facility Charges and FDOT grants.

Mr. Pue presented the memorandum, dated March 4, 2015, along with the proposal from Prime Construction Group, Inc., dated March 12, 2015, for the award of H260, Repairs to Enplane Drive Pier Cap No. 5 on Both A and B Sides (Design/Build), at the Orlando International Airport. The scope of services provides repairs to the structural repair of Pier Cap No. 5 on both A and B Sides with temporary supports, attachment of new structural steel components, and replacement of thirteen (13) new diaphragms on both A and B Sides. Also included is Mainteiance of Traffic (MOT) and relocation of roadway lights.

The Director of Small Business Development has reviewed the subject contract's proposed MWBE/LDB specifications and determined that Prime Construction Group, Inc. proposes to achieve 6.3% MWBE participation on this Addendum.

Chair Thornton asked Legal Counsel regarding the direct-negotiation process for services greater that \$300,000. Legal Counsel responded that the Aviation Authority's Policy 130.01 (Construction Contracts and Changes) provides that when it is in the best interest of the Aviation Authority to utilize a Continuing Contract for construction projects, the Aviation Authority may seek bids, proposals or a directly-negotiated construction contract addendum, on a competitive or non-competitive basis, without public announcement (advertisement), in accordance with Section 255.103 of the Florida Statutes.

Mr. Patterson noted that, due to the critical nature and timelines of H260, the scope was directly-negotiated with Prime Construction Group, Inc. under its Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with the Aviation Authority. He further stated that Prime Construction Group, Inc. provided similar services under H229 which included repairs to Pier 39; thus, there would be no learning curve and the repairs could be accomplished immediately.

Agenda Item Nos. 12 and 13 were considered in one motion.

Upon motion of Mr. Devine, second by Ms. Churchill, vote carried to recommend to the Aviation Authority Board approval of an Addendum to the Continuing Horizontal Construction Services Agreement with Prime Construction Group, Inc. for H260, for direct-negotiated lump sum amount of \$409,112.00, and include the requirement for Performace and Payment Bonds, with funding from Airport Facilities Renewal and Replacement Funds, subject to Board approval.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Recommendation to Approve the Use of Capital Expenditure Funds for Furniture Replacement in the 80s Wing at the Orlando International Airport

BACKGROUND

The furniture in the passenger hold-rooms on Airside 4 is reaching the end of its design life and it is scheduled to be replaced in Fiscal Year 2016.

ISSUES

The initiation of new service in September 2015 by a new international airline that will utilize the 80s wing on Airside 4 has resulted in a need to replace the furniture prior to Fiscal Year 2016.

The replacement of this furniture requires funding approval in the amount of \$1,500,000 in this Fiscal Year. Following the Aviation Authority's procurement process as defined in Policy, Staff will return to the Aviation Authority Board for final approval before purchase of the furniture.

Approval by the Aviation Authority Board is required to include this expenditure in the Aviation Authority's current year budget.

ALTERNATIVES

The Aviation Authority Board could decide to maintain the original schedule and wait until Fiscal Year 2016 to replace the furniture.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact is not-to-exceed \$1,500,000, with funding from Capital Expenditure Funds.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is respectfully requested that the Aviation Authority Board resolve to (1) approve the use of Capital Expenditure Funds in a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,500,000 for furniture replacement in the passenger hold-rooms on Airside 4 at the Orlando International Airport and (2) request Orlando City Council concurrence to include this expenditure in the Aviation Authority's current year budget.
