Spectrum Sports Performance, Inc. (Spectrum) plans to relocate from Winter Park to 4257 Daubert Street in the City of Orlando. Spectrum is a leader in sports performance training of athletes in the Orlando area. The company offers programs and services for professional, amateur, collegiate, high school and youth athlete, and general and performance fitness. The property was recently annexed into the City of Orlando from Orange County to enable a connection to City sanitary sewer. In addition to the City sewer connection, the 17,000 + sf building is being completely renovated. Spectrum plans to create 25 new full-time jobs as a result of this project. Total capital investment for this project is approximately \$550,000.

Total eligible fees for Spectrum Performance Sports, Inc. under the Business Assistance Program, are \$43,570.66. The BAP will pay fifty percent of eligible fees (\$20,000). The fee breakdown is as follows: Public Right of Way Infrastructure @ 50% = \$21,785.33-1,785.33=\$20,000.
