23 24	For procurement by competitive sealed proposals, invitation to negotiate,
25	and requests for qualifications, participation by veteran business enterprises will
26	receive two percent (2%) of the points in the scoring as provided in the
27	solicitation, when formal scoresheets are utilized in the solicitation. A business
28	which is both a veteran business enterprise and a minority business enterprise or a
29	woman business enterprise will receive a scoring credit for either its status as a
30	veteran business enterprise or as a minority business enterprise or woman
31	business enterprise, but not both, as provided in the solicitation.

36	The veteran business enterprise preference shall not apply to procurements
37	where prohibited by law or disallowed by the terms (i) of any grant or (ii)
38	agreement with the state or federal government. The veteran business enterprise
39	preference shall not apply to procurements to which the Minority Business
40	Enterprise and Women Business Enterprise Program does not apply, pursuant to
41	City Code Chapter 57, or when the Minority and Women Business Enterprise
42	Official has reduced or waived the goals for a particular solicitation.

45 46	<b>SECTION TWO. CODIFICATION.</b> The City Clerk and the City Attorney shall cause the Code of the City of Orlando, Florida, to be amended as provided by this ordinance and may

55	application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other
56	provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid
57	provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
