Due to the specialized scope and license/certifications required for all personnel working on any vertical transportation, it is the prime contractor responsibility to perform a large portion of this project. There is a very limited scope of work available to sub contract. As a result, the M/WBE goals for this project have been waived.

Based upon this office's interaction with **KONE**, **Inc.** and their submittal of agreements to subcontract with the named firms, we find good faith efforts substantiated and bid responsive.

In the event that **KONE**, **Inc.** has not submitted signed subcontract agreements, please remind them of the requirements to execute and submit to this office within seven (7) days after contract award, copies of all Ordinance related subcontracts. **KONE**, **Inc.** should also be informed that any change orders, up or down, require 24% M/WBE participation on the total amount of such change order.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE INFORM **KONE, INC.** THAT ANY MATERIAL CHANGES IN THE CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP HEREINAFTER ESTABLISHED BETWEEN THE PRIME AND THE SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT MUST BE PROMPTLY REPORTED TO MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE OFFICIAL FOR APPROVAL.
