Yamasan will offer a full array of Japanese cuisine. The project consists of a complete interior build out of a 3300 sf vacant space with 67 new seats. Total capital investment for this project is approximately \$250,000. Yamasan will create 8 new jobs through this project. The business is locating to the Mills Park development, in the Mills 50 Main Street District.

Total eligible fees for Yamasan under the Business Assistance Program are \$34,347.26. The BAP will pay fifty percent of eligible fees (\$17,173.63). The fee breakdown is as follows: Sewer Benefit Fee @ 50% = \$8,160.60, Transportation Impact Fee (a) 50% = \$9,013.13.
