Kony Mobile Application Development N15-0209

The Orlando Police Department (OPD) and Technology Management (TM) are requesting approval to award a Mobile Application Development Contract to Kony Services Inc. to deploy a Vehicle for Hire application. The application will allow drivers and businesses to register, apply, pay and download driver and vehicle permits from a computer at any location via the web. A negotiated procurement process was used to develop the scope of work (SOW). Kony expects to spend 6,840 hours to execute the application. The total deployment cost is \$298,000.

Kony is the City's mobile application development platform. The original procurement included software licenses, cloud hosting and training at a cost of \$65,420. Professional services costs of \$22,820 to develop an initial application blueprint were also included in the original PO. The blueprint document required to develop the Vehicle of Hire mobile application was also completed by Kony at a cost of \$75,600.

OPD and TM request authorization to contract with Kony to deploy a Vehicle For Hire mobile application.
