# FY2014/15 BUDGET NEW BUSINESS:

## 1. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND

A. BA15-89, Project No. REM0002\_P - Request to budget the return of funds that the City previously put on deposit for the acquisition of the Northbrook property for the Soccer Stadium. Net Increase in Project Revenue & Expenses: \$2,950,000.

# 2. WASTEWATER RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND

A. BA15-88, Cost Center No. WAS0015\_C and Project No. CIP0169\_P – Public Works – Request to allocate fund balance to replace effluent analyzers and to consolidate monitoring equipment at Conserv II Water Reclamation Facility. The aging analyzers must be replaced to continue to meet water reuse standards. Net Increase in Project Expenses: \$415,000.

## 3. GRANTS FUND

- A. BA15-80, Cost Center No. LEU0001\_C, Grant No. LEU0004\_G & LEU0005\_G and Resolution Orlando Venues Request to budget the 2015-2016 Florida Division of Cultural Affairs General Program Support Grant and the subsequent City match. The Grant Award was approved by City Council on 08/10/15. The grant funds will be used to support and enhance the current educational programming and special events at the Gardens. Net Increase to Grants Fund: \$70,746. Transfer of Existing Funding from Leu Gardens Fund to Designated Revenue Fund: \$70,746.
- B. BA15-81, Grant No. FPR0014\_G and Resolution Families, Parks, & Recreation Request to budget the NRPA Grant for Community Gardens. The grant will assist in the expansion of community gardens throughout the City and implementation of the council adopted Green Works Orlando Community Action Plan to eliminate food deserts and increase the percentage of our food grown locally. The grant award was approved by City Council 8/10/15. Net Increase to Grants Fund: \$8,000.
- C. BA15-82, Grant No. OPD0038\_G Police Request to budget Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) FC/FLM-1021 Agreement approved by City Council on 8/10/15, for overtime reimbursement. Net Increase to Grants Fund: \$6.000.
- D. BA15-83, Grant No. OPD0024\_G Police Request to budget modification #3 of High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas 2014 Program Award approved by City Council on 6/15/15. Net Decrease to Grants Fund: \$1,209.
- E. BA15-85, Grant No. OPD0034\_G Police Request to budget Target Community Engagement Funds Grant Award approved by City Council on 7/27/15, to be used for National Night Out events. Net Increase to Grants Fund: \$4,480.

## 4. JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT 2016 FUND

A. BA15-84, Grant No. OPD0039\_G - Police - Request to budget 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program - Local Solicitation Award approved by City Council on 8/10/15, for the purchase of radios and related equipment. Net Increase: \$169,717.

### 5. HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FUND

A. BR15-18, Grant Nos. HSG0098\_G and HSG0112\_G – Housing - Request to transfer unexpended FY2014/15 program budget to the Housing and Neighborhood Development Services of Central Florida, Inc. (HANDS) to be used to provide prepurchase and foreclosure prevention services to 15 - 20 eligible homebuyers within the City of Orlando. Transfer of Existing Budget: \$15,000.

# 6. STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) FUNDS

- A. BA15-86, Grant Nos. HSG0102\_G and HSG0106\_G Housing Request to budget additional FY 2014/15 SHIP allocation received on 7/01/15 with ten percent allocated toward administrative costs and the remainder to housing strategies. Net Increase: \$72,982.
- B. BA15-87, Cost Center HSG0005\_C and Grant Nos. HSG0092\_G and HSG0102\_G Housing Request to budget SHIP interest previously earned, but not recognized. A portion of this funding will be allocated to administrative costs, with the remainder used to carry out the strategies listed in the City of Orlando's most recent Local Housing Assistance Plan. Net Increase: \$42,467.

## 7. GAS TAX FUND

A. BR15-19, Project Nos. TRE0027\_P, TRE0007\_P and TRE0023\_P - Public Works - Request to budget the Locally Funded Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) approved by City Council on 7/13/15, for additional pedestrian and signalization enhancements beyond the scope of FDOT's resurfacing improvements along Colonial Drive. Transfer of Existing Budget: \$230,708.

## 8. GENERAL FUND

A. Police – OPA0003\_C – Request to drop one (1) Emergency Communications Specialist (S19) and add one (1) Staff Assistant (S20) to maintain division efficiency and to continue to ensure Certification guidelines are met for Communications personnel. No additional Personnel costs will be incurred from this change.

## 9. BUILDING CODE ENFORCEMENT FUND

A. Economic Development – PER0003\_C – Request to drop one (1) Accounting Specialist I (S19) and add one (1) EDIS System Administrator in order to help manage the implementation of the Economic Development Information System. Additional Personnel costs will be covered by existing budget.

### 10. WASTEWATER REVENUE FUND

- A. Public Works WAS0003\_C and WAS0013\_C Request to drop one (1) O&M Manual Writer and Trainer (S14) from WAS0003\_C Industrial Automation Group and add one (1) O&M Manual Writer and Trainer (S14) to WAS0013\_C Compliance and Public Awareness. This position is responsible for educating the public on proper disposal of items that affect the wastewater treatment process and is a better fit under the Compliance and Public Awareness cost center. No additional Personnel costs will be incurred from this change.
- B. Public Works WAS0009\_C Request to drop one (1) Maintenance Worker (L01) and add one (1) Mechanic I/II/III/IV (L02 L05). Additional Personnel costs will be covered by existing budget.

## 11. STORMWATER UTILITY FUND

A. Public Works – STW0003\_C – Request to drop one (1) Utility Service Worker II (L03) and add one (1) Mechanic II – Automotive (L03). No additional Personnel costs will be incurred from this change.
