I. CALL TO ORDER

City Clerk Celeste T. Brown called the meeting to order at 2:09 P.M.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

Nathan Chambers requested a review of the ballots cast in District 6. Ms. lennaco asked if he wanted to review the absentee ballot envelopes or the ballots. Mr. Chambers replied that he wanted to see the ballots. Ms. lennaco advised that the election is still in the auditing process and the ballots are not yet available for review, but that the City will consider this a public records request and arrange a mutually agreeable time and place with Mr. Chambers for the review.

There being no further comment, public comment was concluded.

III. CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES OF CANVASSING BOARD ELECTION DAY MEETING ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015

A draft of the Minutes of the Canvassing Board Election Day Meeting on November 3, 2015 was presented to the Canvassing Board for approval. Commissioner Robert F. Stuart moved to correct the draft minutes as follows:

- Page 1 correct scrivener's error change Orlandio to Orlando
- Page 2 Section V, line 5 insert the words "District 6 candidate" before "Lawanna Gelzer"
- Page 2 correct scrivener's error paragraph titled "SIGNATURE NO MATCHES 92 BALLOTS" change to "SIGNATURE NO MATCH 91 BALLOTS"; in the body of the paragraph change "ninety-two (92) ballot envelopes" to "ninety-one (91) ballot envelopes"; change "25 ballots were ACCEPTED" to "26 ballots were ACCEPTED"; change "67 ballots were REJECTED" to "65 ballots were REJECTED".

The motion was seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown and vote was unanimous to approve the minutes as corrected.

IV. CONSIDERATION OF PRECINCT RESULTS – COMPARISON OF TAPES

Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff member Beverly Willis presented the precinct results and indicated that she and City Clerk Brown had reviewed the precinct results tapes and compared them to the precinct results and they matched. She did explain that there was one un-scanned precinct ballot to be added to the totals due to a poll worker error.

V. CONSIDERATION OF PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff member Pat Heflin presented eight (8) provisional ballots for review by the Canvassing Board:

1. Fred Rodgers - Precinct 4601

Voter voted by absentee ballot and also tried to vote at the polling place (precinct 4601). His signature on file with the SOE and at the polling place matched his signature on his absentee ballot. The polling workers did not allow him to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed him to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to REJECT the provisional ballot because the voter had already cast an absentee ballot.

2. Johnnie Smith - Precinct 6201

Voter voted by absentee ballot and also tried to vote at the polling place (precinct 6201). His signature on file with the SOE and at the polling place matched his signature on his absentee ballot. The polling place staff did not allow him to cast a

vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed him to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to REJECT the provisional ballot because the voter had already cast an absentee ballot.

3. Stephen Cowart - Precinct 2201

Voter did not have any photo identification at polling place, but his signature on file with the SOE did match his signature on the provisional ballot. The polling place staff did not allow him to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed him to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the provisional ballot because the signatures matched.

4. Elizabeth Saxon - Precinct 3201

Voter requested an absentee ballot and ballot was returned with a signature that did not match the signature on file with the SOE office. That absentee ballot was rejected at the Canvassing Board meeting on November 3, 2015. Voter went to polling place to vote and her signature on file with the SOE matched her signature at the polling place. The polling place staff did not allow her to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed her to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the provisional ballot.

5. Dorothy Jones - Precinct 3201

Voter went to the polling place to vote and when her identification was scanned, the system indicated that she had already cast a vote that day. Voter claimed that she had not cast a vote that day. The poll workers did not allow her to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed her to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Her signature on the provisional ballot matched the signature on file with the SOE. The Canvassing Board asked for further research from SOE staff. After research, SOE staff member Sara Osborne reported that the records showed that someone with a completely different (illegible scrawl) signature had signed in at the precinct and SOE records showed a valid vote for Dorothy Jones. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to REJECT the provisional ballot because the Canvassing Board could not ascertain whether Ms. Jones had voted or not.

6. Patricia May Butler Conklin Cerf - Precinct 4401

Voter had two records on file with the SOE office; one record had been removed and one record was valid. When voter went to the polling place to cast a vote, the "removed" record automatically came up. The poll workers did not allow her to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed her to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Voter's signature on file with the SOE matched her signature on the provisional ballot envelope and no absentee ballot had already

been cast by the voter. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the provisional ballot.

7. Juan P. Rodriguez – Precinct 4501

Voter went to polling place to cast a vote and was informed that he had already voted by absentee ballot. The poll workers did not allow him to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed him to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Research by SOE staff determined that the voter's absentee ballot had been returned to the SOE as undeliverable. Voter's signature on file with the SOE matched his signature on the provisional ballot envelope. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the provisional ballot.

8. Marc Davis - Precinct 4501

Voter went to polling place to cast a vote and was informed that he had already voted by absentee ballot. The poll workers did not allow him to cast a vote into the DS200 at the precinct, but allowed him to vote a provisional ballot for the Canvassing Board to consider. Research by SOE staff determined that the voter's absentee ballot had been returned to the SOE office as undeliverable. Voter's signature on file with the SOE office matched his signature on the provisional ballot envelope. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the provisional ballot.

It was determined by the Canvassing Board that there were no voter intent issues on the accepted provisional ballots. Commissioner Robert F. Stuart unsealed and separated the ballot envelopes from the ballots and SOE staff member Beverly Willis manually inspected the ballots and manually added the votes as cast on the ballots.

Orange County Supervisor of Elections staff member Lucy Melendez presented three (3) absentee ballots for review by the Canvassing Board:

1. Gloria A. Williams

Two absentee ballots were returned to the SOE. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, to REJECT the second absentee ballot.

2. Daniel Fis

This voter's absentee ballot had been presented to the Canvassing Board on Tuesday, November 3, 2015 (Election Day) and was rejected because the ballot had been signed by someone who did not have an absentee ballot request on file with the SOE office. It was later determined that there was an absentee ballot request on file with the SOE office for the person who signed the absentee envelope. It was

moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the absentee ballot.

3. Julia Nichole Wilkerson

This voter's absentee ballot had been presented to the Canvassing Board on Tuesday, November 3, 2015 (Election Day) and was rejected because the ballot had been signed by someone other than the voter (Maggie Wilkerson) and the voter did not have an absentee ballot request on file with the SOE office. It was later determined that there was an absentee ballot request on file for Maggie Wilkerson. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to ACCEPT the absentee ballot.

The Canvassing Board recessed at 3:03 P.M. and reconvened at 3:21 P.M.

After the Board reconvened, SOE staff member Beverly Willis presented to the Canvassing Board the amended results reports based on the acceptance of the aforementioned provisional and absentee ballots. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to confirm the amended reports as presented by Beverly Willis.

The Canvassing Board recessed at 3:26 P.M. and reconvened at 3:29 P.M.

VI. CONSIDERATION OF FINAL TOTALS AND CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

The Canvassing Board received and reviewed the City of Orlando Official Results of the 2015 General Election as well as the precinct by precinct results. It was moved by Commissioner Robert F. Stuart, seconded by Chair Celeste T. Brown, and vote was unanimous to accept the Official Results of the 2015 City of Orlando General Election and certify the results of the race for Mayor, District 4 City Commissioner and District 6 City Commissioner as the Official Results as reflected on the attached.

VII. AUDIT

In accordance with Section 101.591, Florida Statutes regarding Voting Systems audits, the Canvassing Board randomly selected Precinct 6401 (during its Tuesday, November 3rd meeting) and a manual audit was performed in accordance with the procedures required by law. A manual count of election ballots by SOE staff members resulted in the following:
