12. JUSTIFICATION: Document justification for request. The project is needed to correct deficiencies and make improvements to the sanitary sewer collection system in the College Park area. Specifically, the work consists of: fill all the cracks and voids on the interior walls of the manhole and coat the entire riser to the bottom of the ring and cover with calcium aluminate grout for three (3) manholes; prepare the surface, grout fill all cracks and voids with calcium aluminate or other approved grout, seal leaks with hydraulic cement, and coat the entire interior of the manhole with coal tar epoxy for twelve (12) manholes; remove and replace the manhole frame and cover, adjust to proper grade, fill voids and coat any exposed surface areas with calcium aluminate grout for two (2) manholes; clean and install a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) point lining at four (4) locations; open cut and replace the 12" gravity sanitary sewer pipes and manholes between MH20139 and MH 20056 near the intersection of North Lake Adair Boulevard and Edgewater Drive.
