Short description of the project or program that will be pursued with grant funding:

The Parramore community is one of the more economically challenged neighborhoods in the City and there is a need to serve residents with a more viable bikeway network. One important aspect of this project is the Parramore Community School that will handle an estimated 1,211 students, medical clinic, and a Boys and Girls Club. The existing bicycle infrastructure within the Parramore neighborhood consists of bicycle lanes along three (3) main corridors. To further enhance the existing bicycle infrastructure there is a need to improve the existing corridors with pavement markings that provide a higher visibility for cyclists from motorists.

Short description of the problem or need for the project or program:

The proposed resurfacing of Westmoreland Drive from Gore Street to Amelia Street provides a direct link to the new Parramore Community School. By installing green pavement markings to the resurfacing project will provide a more defined and visible north/south bicycle route for residents and students cycling through the Parramore neighborhood. The overall goal of the project is to increase the bikeability of the neighborhood while providing a safer connection to the Parramore Community School.
