- WHEREAS, the week of March 28 to April 2, 2016 has been reserved as National Community Development Week to celebrate the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program; and
- WHEREAS, the CDBG and HOME Programs contribute annual funding to local governments to provide decent, safe and affordable housing and economic opportunities to low and moderate income persons; and
