

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
2 THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, RELATING
3 TO AFTERHOURS NIGHTCLUBS; AMENDING
4 ORDINANCE NO. 2015-58 TO REQUIRE THAT
5 THE CITY OF ORLANDO NIGHTCLUBS TASK
6 FORCE FINISH ITS INVESTIGATION AND
7 REPORT BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2016; PROVIDING
8 FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF
9 SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE
10 DATE.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO,
13 FLORIDA:

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15 SECTION 1. SECTION 5, AMENDED. Section 5 of City of Orlando Ordinance
16 No. 2015-58 is hereby amended as follows:

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18 SECTION 5. MORATORIUM TASK FORCE. Within 14 days of
19 the effective date of this ordinance, the City Attorney and the Chief of
20 Police shall appoint a working committee of City officials to be known as
21 the "City of Orlando Nightclubs Task Force (the "Task Force"). The
22 primary purpose of the Task Force is to recommend findings of fact to the
23 Mayor regarding nightclubs (including afterhours nightclubs), how
24 nightclubs may or may not exacerbate the existing public health, safety,
25 and welfare challenges presented by the nighttime entertainment
26 economy, especially in Downtown Orlando, but also throughout the City
27 of Orlando, and the manner by which existing state and City laws already
28 regulate the nighttime entertainment economy. The Task Force is hereby
29 constituted as and shall undertake its work as a "Staff Panel" pursuant to
30 City of Orlando Policy and Procedure 161.4. The Task Force shall
31 investigate and report by no later than ~~July 1~~September 1, 2016, on such
32 matters that in its consideration advances its primary purpose, to include
33 the following:

35 a. The number and location of nightclubs within the City of
36 Orlando.

38 b. The prevalence of nightclubs in some of Orlando's peer cities
39 (or counties).

41 c. The reported impacts of nightclubs on the public health, safety,
42 and welfare, particularly as it relates to crime and negative
43 effects on surrounding land uses.

45 d. Identify state and local laws (here in Florida and also outside of
46 Florida) currently regulating nightclubs.

48 e. The common business methods of nightclubs.
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50 f. Gather and analyze representative studies and reports on the
51 impact of nightclubs on the public health, safety, and welfare.

53 **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or its
54 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect
55 other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the
56 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are
57 severable.
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59 **SECTION 3. SCRIVENER'S ERROR.** The city attorney may correct scrivener's
60 errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city
61 clerk.

63 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance takes effect immediately upon
64 adoption.
