# RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS RIGHT OF WAY ENCROACHMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT (this "Agreement"), is made and entered into this 21cr day of April , 2016, by and between the City of Orlando, Florida, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, whose address is 400 S. Orange Avenue, Orlando, Fl, 32802 (the "City"), and Diane L. Loar and Elaine S. Harbilas whose address is 818 E. Church Street, Orlando, FL, 32801-2925; (collectively the "Owner").

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Owner is the owner of that certain real property located at 818 East Church Street, Orlando, Florida, 32801, as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Owner has constructed certain brick driveway improvements located in the right-of-way for South Hyer Street, "Right-of-way", adjacent to the Property, (collectively, the "Improvements") and

WHEREAS, Section 61.230 of the Orlando City Code requires that the Owner enter into a binding agreement providing for the encroachment of the Improvements into the Right-of-Way and providing for removal of the Improvements under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, absent exceptional circumstances, the City would not generally approve of the Owner's placement of the Improvements within the existing Right-of-Way described above; and

WHEREAS, the City has found exceptional circumstances in this case and has also found that construction and maintenance of the Improvements has not and will not compromise public safety and traffic flow in the area, and has therefore approved of the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, in consideration for the City's approval of the Improvements, the Owner has agreed, at its sole cost and expense, to maintain, repair, and operate said Improvements, in perpetuity, and

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WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to memorialize their agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporated into the substantive body of this Agreement.
- 2. <u>Encroachment</u>. The City hereby grants permission for the encroachment of the Improvements into the Right-of-Way strictly limited to the area described and shown in <u>Exhibit B</u>, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.
- 3. Release. Owner hereby releases the City, its representatives, employees and elected officials from any and all damages, claims, or liability, with respect to the Improvements, that may arise due to the City's operation and maintenance of its Right-of-Way.
- 4. <u>Priority of City's Right-of Way</u>. The Improvements shall not be operated or maintained in such a manner so as to interfere, in any way, with the City's operation or maintenance of its Right-of-Way.
- 5. <u>Joinder and Consent</u>. Simultaneously with the execution of this Agreement, the Owner hereby agrees to obtain a Joinder and Consent to this Agreement from any superior interest, right, title, lien, or encumbrance to the Property. The Joinder and Consent shall subordinate the particular interest to this Agreement.
- 6. <u>Indemnification</u>. The Owner agrees that it shall release, indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City, its representatives, employees and elected and appointed officials from and against all claims, damages, loss and expenses of any sort including reasonable attorney's fees and costs including appeals, arising out of or resulting from any tort, intentional action, negligent act or omission of the Owner, its tenants, agents, subcontractors, or anyone for whose act or acts any of them may be liable, for acts or omissions occurring in that portion of the street Right-of-Way on, under or through which the Improvements are constructed or resulting from the operation or maintenance of the Improvements, or arising, in any way, from this Agreement.
- 7. <u>Insurance.</u> Owner shall possess and maintain, at all times during construction, operation and maintenance of the Project within the City's Right-of-Way, general homeowner's liability insurance in an amount sufficient to protect the City from any covered liability, claims, damages, losses or expenses arising from or out of or in any was connected with construction, operation or maintenance of the Project within the City's Right-of-Way. City shall be named as an additional insured on the liability policy and City may request proof of such insurance at any time.
- 8. <u>Improvements</u>. In consideration for the City's consent to construction and maintenance of the Improvements within the Right-of-way, as described herein, the Owner agrees, at its sole cost and expense, to construct, maintain, repair and operate the Improvements, in perpetuity, consistent with reasonable engineering standards and all applicable laws, codes, and regulations.

- 9. <u>City Inspection</u>. The City shall have the right, but not the obligation, to inspect the Improvements to determine whether they have been properly constructed and are being properly maintained. If the City determines, in its sole discretion, that the Improvements have not been properly constructed or are not being properly maintained, the City shall notify the Owner in writing of said determination and of the appropriate construction, repair or maintenance activities the Owner must undertake. The Owner shall have ten (10) days to make said repairs or accomplish said maintenance activities, after which time the City may perform such construction, repairs or maintenance and invoice the Owner for all reasonable costs associated therewith. If the Owner fails to pay the invoices within thirty (30) days of receipt thereof, the amount shall become a lien against the Property in the same manner as a special assessment lien, and enforced as provided by law. The City may conduct emergency repairs or maintenance activities on the Improvements without notice to the Owner. The cost of said emergency repairs shall be paid by the Owner in the manner described above, including the imposition of liens.
- 10. Notices. Any notices which may be permitted or required hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given as of the date and time the same are personally delivered, transmitted electronically (i.e., by telecopier device) or within three (3) days after depositing with the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, or within one (1) day after depositing with Federal Express or other overnight delivery service from which a receipt may be obtained, and addressed as follows:

or to such other address as either party hereto shall from time to time designate to the other party by notice in writing as herein provided.

- 11. <u>Modification</u>. This Agreement may not be amended, modified, altered, or changed in any respect whatsoever, except by a further Agreement in writing duly executed by the parties and recorded in the Public Records of Orange County, Florida.
- 12. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall constitute covenants running with the land, and all rights and privileges granted herein shall be appurtenant

to the lands herein described, and, except as hereinafter set forth, shall run with said lands forever and be binding upon and inure to the benefit of and be enforceable by the heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto and shall continue in perpetuity, unless otherwise modified in writing by the parties hereto.

- 13. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto with respect to the transactions contemplated herein, and it supersedes all prior understandings or agreements between the parties.
- 14. Attorneys' Fees. In the event of any dispute hereunder or of any action to interpret or enforce this Agreement, any provision hereof or any matter arising herefrom, each party shall bear its own costs, fees and expenses, including, but not limited to, witness fees, expert fees, consultant fees, attorney (in-house and outside counsel), paralegal and legal assistant fees, costs and expenses and other professional fees, costs and expenses whether suit be brought or not, and whether in settlement, in any declaratory action, at trial or on appeal.
- 15. <u>Section Headings</u>. The section headings as used herein are for convenience of reference only and shall not be deemed to vary the content of this Agreement or the covenants, agreements, representations and warranties herein set forth, or limit the provisions or scope of any section herein.
- 16. <u>Severability</u>. This Agreement is intended to be performed in accordance with, and only to the extent permitted by, all applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations. If any provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, for any reason and to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby, but rather shall be enforced to the greatest extent permitted by law.
- 17. Recording of Agreement. The Owner shall be responsible for recording this Agreement (including all costs associated therewith) within the Public Records of Orange County, Florida and shall send a copy of said recorded Agreement to the City within thirty (30) days of the execution of this Agreement.
- 18. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of Florida.
- 19. <u>Controlling Laws</u>. The parties to this Agreement agree to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to the utilization of the property under this Agreement.
- 20. <u>Legal Counsel</u>. Owner acknowledges that he has had ample opportunity to seek and consult with independent legal counsel prior to executing this Agreement, and that Owner represents and warrants that he has sought such independent legal advice and counsel or has knowingly and voluntarily waived such right.
- 21. <u>Negotiation</u>. The parties to this Agreement acknowledge that all terms of this Agreement were negotiated at arms length and that this Agreement and all documents executed in connection herewith were prepared and executed without undue influence by any party or on any

party. Further, this Agreement was drafted jointly by all parties, and no parties are entitled to the benefit of any rules of construction with respect to the interpretation of any terms, conditions or provisions of this Agreement in favor of or against any person or party who drafted this Agreement.

- 22. Termination of License and Removal of Encroachment. City retains the right to revoke this license by notifying the Owner in writing at the address listed in the initial paragraph of this Agreement. Owner shall remove the Improvements, and any and all attendant encroachments, from the City's Right-of-Way, within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of the written notice to Owner, whether or not the notice is received by Owner. If Owner fails to remove the Improvements and attendant encroachments, within the above-described time frame, the City may remove same and charge the cost of removal to the Owner. Should Owner fail to pay the costs of City's removal of the Improvement and attendant encroachments within thirty (30) days of the City's request, the City may file a lien against the property described in Exhibit "A" to accrue interest at the statutory rate, and enforced as provided by law.
- 23. <u>Effective Date.</u> The effective date of this Agreement is the date of its execution by the last person to execute it.
