DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Public Comment: None.

- 1. <u>2016-2017 Proposed Budget and Resolution</u> Mercedes Blanca reviewed the 2016-2017 Proposed Budget and Resolution. The Board reviewed various reports supporting the proposed Budget. The DDB Budget and Resolution will be presented at the next DDB Board Meeting on August 24, 2016.
- 2. <u>2016-2017 DDB/CRA Cost Share Agreement</u> Mercedes Blanca explained the 2016-2017 DDB/CRA Cost Share Agreement.

- 3. <u>2016-2017 City Services Agreement</u> Mercedes Blanca reviewed the 2016-2017 City Services Agreement. The only provisions that have changed from last year's agreement are the dates and the dollar amount to be provided to the City for its services.
- 4. <u>2016-2017 Special Event Funding</u> Mercedes Blanca advised that 61 requests were received for this year's special event funding in the amount of \$168,250. Ms. Blanca advised that staff recommends \$131,500 in funding to applicants. Ms. Blanca explained that due to the increase in special event funding requests for this upcoming fiscal year, there were additional benchmarks put in place according to each individual event. Mr. Chatmon advised the Board that this fiscal year there will be surveys sent out to businesses after DDB sponsored events in an attempt to capture feedback about the events, such as financial gain, and DDB staff will be assigned to attend all large scale events.
- 5. **2016-2017 Community Concert Funding** Mercedes Blanca advised that 9 requests were received this year for Community Concert Funding in the amount of \$164,750. Ms. Blanca explained that staff recommends \$131,250 in funding to applicants leaving a contingency of \$17,750.
