We expect the internet connectivity to have an Uptime of 99.95 or better. Less than that may cause delays.

D) Proposer Specific Questions, Amano McGann (iParc Professional) System:

### Proposal Pg.:

- How are the IP devices connected?
  - IP Telecom System
     Connect via internet to city's master system.
  - IP Cameras
     Connect via internet to city's CCTV system or to Amano NVR.
  - Handheld units
     Connect to iParcProfessional Cloud server using Cellular to internet.

### **Presentation Questions**

- A) General Questions for Proposers:
  - 1. Does any aspect of the operation of the application require RDP access from contractor? For end user operation no. For support management yes.
  - 2. What is the maximum amount of time that any one site (location) can be disconnected from the City network before operations at the site are impacted?

    For a Cloud hosted solution, there is not a specific need to be connected to the City's network for transactional operations. If the IP cameras and VoIP intercoms will utilize a City network, they would be impacted immediately upon disconnection.
  - 3. What is the maximum amount of time that any one site (location) can be disconnected from the internet before operations at the site are impacted?

    There is not a specific time. When internet connection is lost, the City's team won't have access to manage the system (run reports, change card status etc.). Once internet connection is disconnected each device will begin to store data. Capacity limits are as follows:
    - 1000 transactions for card readers
    - 1000 for revenue device transactions (validations, pre-pays, etc.)
    - 500 credit card transactions.
  - 4. Does the application or services require an IP protocol that does not run over TCP?

    No. We no longer use ICMP or such.
  - 5. Are there any aspects of the application that require streaming video?

    Depends on how the cameras will be used. They can either use streaming images or still images.
  - Can media access control address (MAC address) security be enabled on connected devices?
     Our system does not use MAC address as part of its security. However, firewall rules could still be used to manage this type of security.
  - 7. Will TM Security handle provision of access to the application?
    Typically, this is handled by Centrinet but can be managed by TM Security in partnership with Centrinet.
  - 8. Will firmware upgrades to all component devices (handhelds, PC devices, readers, etc) be a part of maintenance? This question is on top of software upgrades.

    Yes.

How will door access readers be used?

These are existing door readers currently being used in the Parking Division offices. They are used to secure the Accounting office, Computer room, Front door, back door and inner front door next to Receptionist.

How is encryption enabled on the lane devices?

Lane devices need to be registered on the AMI server and secure connection is made via TLS1.2.

How is the Workday integration planned for? Need more details.

The current interface we have deployed with Workday provides us with a CSV file that we use to populate or update our parker data base with the required permission levels for card holders. Other options could be provided such as sending data to Workday about actual card usages or hourly charges. Handshaking with other systems is something we have significant experience with but we need to know the desired results the City is looking for before providing a spec to agree on.

- 49 How will emails be sent?
  - Is there City SMTP service connections from City locations required? Yes
- Client browser supported is MS IE Explore and FireFox.
  - What version of IE is supported? IE11
  - What version of FireFox is supported? 41.0.1

How is the Bluetooth handhelds connections secured?

The Handheld requires a PIN to connect using Bluetooth and no personal data is communicated over this technology

What model is the database? (SQL, DB2, Oracle) MS SQL

What phone carrier do your handheld devices support? Verizon is preferred but also support AT&T, Sprint

Will the printers utilize wireless or physical connections? The event hand held uses Bluetooth communications to print a receipt and vend the gate after transaction is complete.
