

ANNUAL REPORT FISCAL YEAR 2015-16

I. PURPOSE

- A. ESTABLISHED. The Nominating Board is established by City Code Section 2.115 with the purpose of making recommendations to the Mayor for citizens to be appointed to boards and Multi-jurisdictional boards.
- B. Purpose and Duties. As outlined in Section 2 of the Orlando City Code, the purpose and duties of the Nominating Board are:
 - 1. To make recommendations to the Mayor of qualified individuals for appointment to boards and multi-jurisdictional boards, except the Nominating Board itself. The Mayor reserves the right to accept, reject or modify the recommendation. The appointments made by the Mayor are confirmed by City Council.
 - To coordinate, along with the appropriate City staff, all functions regarding advertisments of vacancies on boards, the planning of orientation sessions to municipal government for new board members, and the monitoring of any other matters dealing with citizen participation on boards and multi-jurisdictional boards.
 - 3. To perform such other undertakings related to boards as the City Council may assign the Nominating Board.
- C. GOAL OF THE BOARD. The goal of the Nominating Board is to ensure the membership of the City boards reflects the unique diversity of the City in terms of gender, race, ethnicity, age and geography.

II. ADMINISTRATION

- A. STAFF. The City Clerk provides staff support and administration for the Nominating Board. Key staff are as follows:
 - 1. Amy Iennaco, Chief Assistant City Attorney/Interim City Clerk
 - 2. Stephanie Herdocia, Board Coordinator
- B. STAFF CHANGES. The Nominating Board Recording Secretary, Kyle Reynolds, transferred to another department with the City of Orlando in August 2016. Stephanie Herdocia was hired to replace Mr. Reynolds in September 2016.

III. BOARD MEMBERS

- A. NUMBER. The Nominating Board has nine (9) members which are appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by City Council.
- B. REQUIREMENTS. Each member is eligible to serve two (2) 2-year terms.
