Features

- 1 Amphitheater Stage** - Conceptual design based on St. Augustine Amphitheater which has 4,000-4,500 fixed seats; grass seating area with no fixed seats proposed in this plan. Includes loading, back stage and dressing facilities
- 2 Concession/Rest Rooms** - Can be operated daily or only for amphitheater or special events and festivals
- 3 Art/Retention Wall** - To accommodate grade changes of amphitheater bowl; provide decorative element
- 4 Concession/Rest Rooms** - Can be operated daily or only for amphitheater or special events and festivals
- 5 Festival Plaza** - For amphitheater or special events and festivals. Engineered to accommodate vendor tents, trailers and/or trucks
- 6 Rosalind Beach** - Where the park meets the lake, water quality issues will likely prohibit swimming and aquatic activities but not scenic views and sand between your toes
- 7 Potential Vendor Locations** - permit tent facilities and structures

This plan is intended to convey a potential vision for the future redevelopment of Lake Eola Park and while based on actual built examples as well as common engineering and architectural guidelines, this plan should be viewed as conceptual and schematic in nature.

Functions

- 1 Loading Dock and Tractor Trailer Parking** - Designed to accommodate 3-4 WB 50 trucks with trailers
- 2 Potential Lower Bowl Canopy**
- 3 Concession/Restroom Subterranean Area**
- 4 Secured Limits** - For paid private amphitheater events and contained alcohol sales
- 5 One-way Rosalind Vehicle Access**
- 6 Central Blvd.** - On street parking and west bound lane can be closed for staging of events and vendors
- 7 Rosalind Ave.** - On street parking and north bound lane can be closed for staging of events and vendors
- 8 Sidewalk Park By Pass** - During private and secured events
- 9 Lymmo Grapefruit Line** - Can operate during all types of events
