Suspending Free First Monday Admissions in 2018 on January 1, February 5, March 5, April 2, and May 7 will help defray costs of the Nature Connects Art with Lego Bricks exhitibt. Our 2017 Dinosaur exhibit increased admission revenues by \$12,500 due to 3 suspended free days.
