**1. DESCRIPTION:** In FY 2016-2017, the City of Orlando is awarding a total of \$77,000 through the second cycle of the Mayor's Matching Grant Program. This represents awards ranging from \$3,500 to \$10,000 to 9 schools and 501(c)3 non-profit organizations. Five neighborhood organizations are awarded grants of up to \$5,000. The grant term will commence on July 1, 2017 and will be completed on or before June 30, 2018. Schools and tax-exempt 501(c)3 non-profit organizations are awarded matching grants up to \$10,000 and are encouraged to partner with neighborhood organizations, community groups and business partners to offer programs that engage our City's youth in constructive, adult supervised activities during non-school hours. Neighborhood organizations are awarded matching grants of up to \$5,000 to implement physical improvements, sustainability, public safety or educational projects that benefit neighborhood residents. All grant awards are matched dollar for dollar by the applicant using a combination of volunteer labor, cash and/or in-kind donations of goods or services.
