PARTIAL RELEASE OF EASEMENT
(44 E Vanderbilt Street)

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2017, by the ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION, of the City of Orlando, Florida, whose address is 100 West Anderson Street, Orlando, Florida 32801, and the CITY OF ORLANDO, a municipal corporation, whose address is 400 S. Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32801, for the use and benefit of the ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION, as parties of the first part, and MCHERE INVESTMENT CO., INC., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, as party of the second part;

WITNESSETH:

That pursuant to due and lawful authority, and pursuant to the directions of the Orlando Utilities Commission, the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents do hereby remise, release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, their successors and assigns, forever, all of their right, title, and interest in and to the Easement over and under the land hereinafter described, which was granted by MCHERE INVESTMENT CO., INC., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, unto the party of the first part herein by an easement dated the 26th day of January, 1940, and recorded in Deed Book 543, Page 556, of the Public Records of Orange County, Florida, on, over, through, across and under the land situate in the County of Orange and State of Florida, described as follows, to-wit:

HEREIN BY THIS AGREEMENT

PROVIDED that nothing contained herein shall impair, alter or diminish the easement rights of the party of the first part on the remaining part of the easement area not hereby released, or any of the rights and remedies of the party of the first part related thereto.

TOGETHER with all rights, including, without limitation, all rights of ingress and egress to, over and under the said land, granted to the party of the first part herein, in and by the aforesaid instruments dated the 26th day of January, 1940.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said CITY OF ORLANDO has caused these presents to be executed in its name by its Mayor, Pro-Tem and its municipal corporate seal to be affixed, attested by its City Clerk; and the said ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION has caused these presents to be executed in its name by its General Manager & CEO and its seal to be affixed, attested by its Assistant Secretary, all in pursuance of due and legal authority, on the day and year first above written.

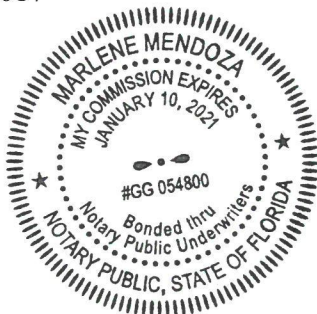
